

All verses are from the Amplified Bible, or Amplified Bible, Classic Version (see pg 78)

In reading these verses remember:

Hebrews 13:8 Jesus Christ, the Messiah, is always the same, yesterday, today, yes, and forever to the ages. God cannot change, everything He did in the past for anyone in Scripture, His heart is the same toward you and He will do the same for you today.

Acts 10:34 And Peter opened his mouth and said: Most certainly and thoroughly I now perceive and understand that God shows no partiality and is no respecter of persons.

Romans 2:11 For God shows no partiality, with Him one man is not different from another. God doesn't find one person to be more deserving and worthy than another; if God did it for someone in these Scripture verses, He is equally obliged under His justice system to do it for you; He is not partial to someone who works harder for Him or who prays more or worships more, or misses the mark less, He sees everyone covered with Jesus' blood, righteous and equally worthy.

Any verse that indicated the promise or blessing is for a person in right standing with God, or for the righteous man, or for the obedient man is for every Christian no matter what you think your current spiritual status is. God can only see Christ's obedience and Christ's righteousness (right standing) when he looks at us. Because Christ was obedient, and he became our righteousness, we are in right standing with God and thus eligible for every blessing of obedience or righteousness. **Rom 5:19 For just as through one man's disobedience [his failure to hear, his carelessness] the many were made sinners, so through the obedience of the one Man the many will be made righteous and acceptable to God and brought into right standing with Him.** **2 Cor 5:21 He made Christ who knew no sin to [judicially] be sin on our behalf, so that in Him we would become the righteousness of God [that is, we would be made acceptable to Him and placed in a right relationship with Him by His gracious lovingkindness].**

Jeremiah 23:28 He who has My word, let him speak My word faithfully.

II Cor 4:13 We have the same spirit of faith as he had, who wrote in Scripture, "I believed, therefore I spoke." We also believe, therefore we also speak.

Rom 18:20-21 Man's [moral] self shall be filled with the fruit of his mouth; and with the consequence of his words he must be satisfied [whether good or evil]. Death and life are in the power of the tongue, and they who indulge in it shall eat the fruit of it [for death or life].

Let the content of these verses be your verbal response to other people and to circumstances, let them fill your speech and prayers. **Isaiah 55:11 So shall My word be that goes forth out of My mouth: it shall not return to Me void [without producing any effect, useless], but it shall accomplish that which I please and purpose, and it shall prosper in the thing for which I sent it.**

BLESSINGS/FAVOR

Gen 12:2 And I will make you a great nation, and I will bless you [abundantly], and make your name great (exalted, distinguished); and you shall be a blessing [a source of great good to others.]

Gen 12:3 And I will bless (do good for, benefit) those who bless you, and I will curse [that is, subject to My wrath and judgment] the one who curses (despises, dishonors, has contempt for) you. And in you all the families (nations) of the earth will be blessed.

Gen 24:1 And the Lord had blessed Abraham in all things. Note, this is part of the blessing of Abraham that is ours.

Gen 32:12 And You [Lord] said, I will certainly make you prosper and make your descendants as [numerous as] the sand of the sea, which is too great to be counted.

Gen 39:2 The Lord was with Joseph, and he [even though a slave] became a successful *and* prosperous man.

Ex 23:25 You shall serve [only] the Lord your God, and He shall bless your bread and water. I will also remove sickness from among you.

Ex 31:3 I have filled him with the Spirit of God in wisdom *and* skill, in understanding *and* intelligence, in knowledge, and in all kinds of craftsmanship.

Num 23:19-20 God is not a man, that He should lie, nor a son of man, that He should repent. Has He said, and will He not do it? Or has He spoken and will He not make it good *and* fulfill it? Behold, I have received *His command* to bless [Israel]. He has blessed, and I cannot reverse it. Note, no person or principality can reverse or modify a single blessing of God.

Deut 7:14 You shall be blessed above all peoples.

Deut 28: 2-6 All these blessings will come upon you and overtake you if you pay attention to the voice of the Lord your God. You *will be* blessed in the city, and you *will be* blessed in the field. The offspring of your body and the produce of your ground and the offspring of your animals, the offspring of your herd and the young of your flock *will be* blessed. Your basket and your kneading bowl *will be* blessed. You *will be* blessed when you come in and you *will be* blessed when you go out.

Deut 28: 12 The Lord will open for you His good treasure house, the heavens, to give rain to your land in its season and to bless all the work of your hand; and you will lend to many nations, but you will not borrow.

Deut 28:13 The Lord will make you the head (leader) and not the tail (follower); and you will be above only, and you will not be beneath. Note, this includes circumstances, you are not beneath circumstances or subject to them.

Job 22:28 You will also decide *and* decree a thing, and it will be established for you; And the light [of God's favor] will shine upon your ways.

Ps 5:12 For You, O Lord, bless the righteous man [the one who is in right standing with You]; as with a shield You will surround him with goodwill (pleasure and favor).

Ps 21:3 For You send blessings of good things to meet him; You set a crown of pure gold on his head.

Ps 21:6 For You make him to be blessed and a blessing forever. You make him exceedingly glad with the joy of Your presence.

Ps 23:6 Surely *or* only goodness, mercy, *and* unfailing love shall follow me all the days of my life (Hebrew word for follow = pursuit, hunting me down).

Ps 40:5 Many, O Lord my God, are the wonderful works which You have done, and Your thoughts toward us.

Ps 57:2 Who performs on my behalf *and* rewards me [Who brings to pass His purposes for me and surely completes them]!

Ps. 84:11 For the Lord God is a Sun and Shield; the Lord bestows [present] grace *and* favor and [future] glory (honor, splendor, and heavenly bliss)! No good thing will He withhold.

Ps 103:4-5 Who redeems your life from the pit *and* corruption, Who beautifies, dignifies, *and* crowns you with loving-kindness and tender mercy; Who satisfies your mouth [your necessity and desire at your personal age and situation] with good so that your youth, renewed, is like the eagle's [strong, overcoming, soaring]!

Ps 115:12 The Lord has been mindful of us, He will bless us. Note, we are on His mind.

Ps 127:2 It is vain for you to rise up early, to take rest late, to eat the bread of [anxious] toil - for He gives [blessings] to His beloved in sleep. Note, you rest, God works; you work, God rests.

Ps 138:8 The Lord will perfect that which concerns me.

Ps 139:17 How precious *and* weighty also are Your thoughts to me, O God! How vast is the sum of them!

Ps 145:8-9 The Lord is gracious and full of compassion, slow to anger and abounding in mercy *and* loving-kindness. The Lord is good to all, and His tender mercies are over all His works [the entirety of things created].

Ps 145:16 You open Your hand and satisfy every living thing with favor.

Ps 148:14 He has lifted up a horn for His people [giving them power, prosperity, dignity, and preeminence].

Prov 10:6 Blessings are upon the head of the righteous (the upright, in right standing with God).

Ecc 2:24 There is nothing better for a man than that he should eat and drink and make himself enjoy good in his labor. Even this, I have seen, is from the hand of God.

Is 49:15-16 (God speaking) I will not forget you. Behold, I have indelibly imprinted (tattooed a picture of) you on the palm of each of My hands.

Is 58:11-12 The Lord will continually guide you, and satisfy your soul in scorched *and* dry places, and give strength to your bones; and you will be like a watered garden, and like a spring of water whose waters do not fail.

Is 58:14 Then will you delight yourself in the Lord, and I will make you to ride on the high places of the earth.

Is 60:9 The Lord your God, the Holy One of Israel, He has beautified *and* glorified you.

Is 60:10-11 In My favor, pleasure, *and* goodwill I have had mercy, love, *and* pity for you. And your gates shall be open continually, they shall not be shut day or night, that men may bring to you the wealth of the nations.

Jer 29:11 For I know the thoughts *and* plans that I have for you, says the Lord, thoughts *and* plans for welfare *and* peace and not for evil, to give you hope in your final outcome.

Dan 11:32 The people who know their God shall prove themselves strong *and* shall stand firm and do exploits [for God].

Joel 2:27 And you shall know, understand, *and* realize that I am in the midst of Israel and that I the Lord am your God and there is none else. My people shall never be put to shame.

Zeph 3:17 The Lord your God is in the midst of you, a Mighty One, a Savior [Who saves]! He will rejoice over you with joy; He will rest [in silent satisfaction] *and* in His love He will be silent *and* make no mention [of past sins, or even recall them]; He will exult over you with singing. Note, the Hebrew word that is translated exult meant twirling and dancing like someone in a celebration parade, God dances, sings and rejoices with joy over you!

Zech 2:8 For he who touches you touches the apple *or* pupil of His eye.

Matt 8:13 Jesus said, it shall be done for you as you have believed.

Luke 4:18-19 The Spirit of the Lord [is] upon Me, because He has anointed Me [the Anointed One, the Messiah] to preach the good news (the Gospel) to the poor; He has sent Me to announce release to the captives and recovery of sight to the blind, to send forth as delivered those who are oppressed [who are downtrodden, bruised, crushed, and broken down by calamity], to proclaim the accepted *and* acceptable year of the Lord [the day when salvation and the free favors of God profusely abound].

John 1:16 For out of His (Jesus') fullness [the superabundance of His grace and truth] we have all received grace upon grace [spiritual blessing upon spiritual blessing, favor upon favor, and gift heaped upon gift]. We are full of every characteristic of God, we are what we should be, we have everything we will ever need, nothing lacking, nothing broken.

John 10:10 The thief comes only in order to steal and kill and destroy. I came that they may have *and* enjoy life, and have it in abundance (to the full, till it overflows). Note, God provides so we can have enjoyment, not so we merely don't lack.

Rom 5:17 For if because of one man's trespass (lapse, offense) death reigned through that one, much more surely will those who receive [God's] overflowing grace (unmerited favor) and the free gift of righteousness [putting them into right standing with Himself] reign as kings in life through the one Man Jesus Christ (the Messiah, the Anointed One).

Rom 8:28 We are assured *and* know that [God being a partner in their labor] all things work together *and* are [fitting into a plan] for good to *and* for those who love God and are called according to [His] design *and* purpose.

Rom 8:30 And those whom He called, He also justified (acquitted, made righteous, putting them into right standing with Himself). And those whom He justified, He also glorified [raising them to a heavenly dignity and condition or state of being].

Rom 8:37 Yet amid all these things we are more than conquerors *and* gain a surpassing victory through Him Who loved us.

II Cor 2:14-16 But thanks be to God, Who in Christ always leads us in triumph [as trophies of Christ's victory] and through us spreads *and* makes evident the fragrance of the knowledge of God everywhere, for we are the sweet fragrance of Christ [which exhales] unto God, it is an aroma from life to life [a vital fragrance, living and fresh].

Eph 1:3 May blessings (praise) be to the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ Who has blessed us in Christ with EVERY spiritual (given by the Holy Spirit) blessing!

II Pet 1:2-4 May grace (God's favor) and peace (which is perfect well-being, all necessary good, all spiritual prosperity, and freedom from fears and agitating passions and moral conflicts) be multiplied to you in [the full, personal, precise, and correct] knowledge of God and of Jesus our Lord. For His divine power has bestowed upon us all things that [are requisite and suited] to life and godliness, through the [full, personal] knowledge of Him Who called us by *and* to His own glory and excellence (virtue). By means of these He has bestowed on us His precious and exceedingly great promises, so that through them you may escape [by flight] from the moral decay (rottenness and corruption) that is in the world because of covetousness (lust and greed), and become sharers (partakers) of the divine nature.

I John 5:4 For everyone born of God is victorious *and* overcomes the world; and this is the victory that has conquered *and* overcome the world - our [continuing, persistent] faith [in Jesus the Son of God].

Rev 3:7-8 These are the words of the Holy One, the True One, He Who has the key of David, Who opens and no one shall shut, Who shuts and no one shall open. See! I have set before you a door wide open which no one is able to shut.

Rev 5:12 Worthy *and* deserving is the Lamb that was sacrificed to receive power and riches and wisdom and might and honor and glory and blessing. Note, everything Jesus received, we receive...Rom 8:17 And if [we are His] children, [then we are His] heirs also: heirs of God and fellow heirs with Christ [sharing His spiritual blessing and inheritance]. I John 4:17 Because as He is, so are we in this world. We have also received power and riches and wisdom and strength and honor and glory and blessing in this world.

INCREASE/PROVISION/FINANCES

Gen 12:2-3 I will make of you a great nation, and I will bless you [with abundant increase of favors] and make your name famous *and* distinguished, and you will be a blessing [dispensing good to others]. And I will bless those who bless you [who confer prosperity or happiness upon you] and curse him who curses *or* uses insolent language toward you; in you will all the families *and* kindred of the earth be blessed [and by you they will bless themselves].

Gen 15:1 I am your Shield, your abundant compensation, *and* your reward shall be exceedingly great.

Gen 39:2 But the Lord was with Joseph, and he [though a slave] was a successful *and* prosperous man.

Lev 26:4-5,10 I will give you rain in its season, and the land will yield her produce and the trees of the field bear their fruit. And your threshing season will last until grape gathering and the grape gathering [time] will last until planting, and you will eat your bread and be filled and live securely in your land. And you shall eat the [abundant] old store of produce long kept, and clear out the old [to make room] for the new.

Deut 1:11 May the Lord, the God of your fathers, make you a thousand times as many as you are and bless you as He has promised you!

Deut 8:7-10 For the Lord your God is bringing you into a good land, a land of brooks of water, of fountains and springs, flowing forth in valleys and hills; A land of wheat and barley, and vines and fig trees and pomegranates, a land of olive trees and honey; a land in which you shall eat food without shortage and lack nothing in it; a land whose stones are iron and out of whose hills you can dig copper. When you have eaten and are full, then you shall bless the Lord your God for all the good land which He has given you.

Deut 8:18 But you shall [earnestly] remember the Lord your God, for it is He Who gives you power to get wealth, that He may establish His covenant which He swore to your fathers, as it is this day.

Deut 28:3-6 You *will be* blessed in the city, and you *will be* blessed in the field. The offspring of your body and the produce of your ground and the offspring of your animals, the offspring of your herd and the young of your flock *will be* blessed. Your basket and your kneading bowl *will be* blessed. You *will be* blessed when you come in and you *will be* blessed when you go out.

Deut 28:8 The Lord will command the blessing upon you in your storehouses and in all that you undertake, and He will bless you in the land which the Lord your God gives you. Note, Hebrew word translated storehouse = multiple places where goods and wealth are stored; they are increasing and expanding and multiplying.

Deut 28:11 The Lord will give you great prosperity, in the offspring of your body and in the offspring of your livestock and the produce of your ground, in the land which the Lord swore to your fathers to give you.

Deut 28:12 The Lord will open for you His good treasure house, the heavens, to give rain to your land in its season and to bless all the work of your hand; and you will lend to many nations, but you will not borrow.

Deut 33:25 And as your days are (Note, your age), so will your strength, your rest *and* security be = the older you get, the more strength, peace and provision.

II Chron 25:9 Amaziah said to the man of God, “But what *shall we* do about the hundred talents which I gave to the troops of Israel?” The man of God answered, “The Lord is able to give you much more than this.”

Job 27:16-17 Though he (the wicked) heaps up silver like dust and piles up clothing like clay, he may prepare it, but the just will wear it and the innocent will divide the silver.

Ps 1:2-3 But his delight *and* desire are in the law of the Lord, and on His law (the precepts, the instructions, the teachings of God) he habitually meditates (ponders and studies) by day and by night. And he shall be like a tree firmly planted [and tended] by the streams of water, ready to bring forth its fruit in its season; its leaf also shall not fade *or* wither; and everything he does shall prosper [and come to maturity].

Ps 23: 5 My [brimming] cup runs over.

Ps 35:27 Let them say continually, “Let the Lord be magnified, who delights *and* takes pleasure in the prosperity of His servant.”

Ps 36:8 They relish *and* feast on the abundance of Your house; and You cause them to drink of the stream of Your pleasures.

Ps 37:18-19 The Lord knows the days of the blameless, and their inheritance will continue forever. They will not be ashamed in the time of evil, and in the days of famine they will have plenty *and* be satisfied.

Ps 37:25 I have been young and now I am old, yet I have not seen the righteous (those in right standing with God) abandoned or his descendants pleading for bread.

Ps 65:11 You crown the year with Your bounty *and* goodness, and the tracks of Your [chariot wheels] drip with fatness.

Ps 81:6 I removed the burden from his shoulder; His hands were freed from the basket.

Ps. 81:10 Open your mouth wide and I will fill it.

Ps. 84:11 The Lord bestows [present] grace *and* favor and [future] glory (honor, splendor, and heavenly bliss)! No good thing will He withhold from those who walk uprightly.

Ps 85:12 Indeed, the Lord will give what is good, and our land will yield its produce.

Ps 103:5 Who satisfies your mouth [your necessity and desire at your personal age and situation] with good.

Ps 115:14 May the Lord give you increase more and more, you and your children.

Ps 127:2 It is vain for you to rise early, to retire late, to eat the bread of anxious labors - for He gives [blessings] to His beloved *even in his* sleep.

Prov 10:22 The blessing of the Lord it makes [truly] rich, and He adds no sorrow to it [for it comes as a blessing from God; neither does toiling increase it].

Prov 11:24-25 There is the one who [generously] scatters [abroad], and yet increases all the more; and there is the one who withholds what is justly due, *but it results* only in want *and* poverty. The liberal person shall be enriched, and he who waters shall himself be watered.

Prov 12:14 From the fruit of his words a man shall be satisfied with good, and the work of a man's hands shall come back to him [as a harvest].

Prov 13:22 A good man leaves an inheritance [of moral stability and goodness] to his children's children, and the wealth of the sinner [finds its way eventually] into the hands of the righteous, for whom it was laid up.

Prov 16:3 Roll your works upon the Lord [commit and trust them wholly to Him; He will cause your thoughts to become agreeable to His will, and] so shall your plans be established *and* succeed.

Prov 22:7 The rich rule over the poor, and the borrower is servant to the lender.

Prov 22:9 He who is generous will be blessed, for he gives some of his food to the poor.

Prov 22:16 He who oppresses *or* exploits the poor to get more for himself or who gives to the rich [to gain influence and favor], will only come to poverty.

Prov 23:4 Do not weary yourself [with the overwhelming desire] to gain wealth; cease from your own [human] wisdom.

Prov 28:8 He who by charging excessive interest *and* who by unjust efforts to get gain increases his material possession gathers it for him [to spend] who is kind *and* generous to the poor.

Prov 28:25 He who is of a greedy spirit stirs up strife, but he who puts his trust in the Lord shall be enriched *and* blessed.

Ecc 2:26 For to the person who pleases Him God gives wisdom, knowledge, and joy; but to the sinner He gives the work of gathering and collecting so that he may give to one who pleases God.

Is 40:26 Through the greatness of His might and because He is strong in power, not one is missing *or* lacks anything.

Is 45:3 I will give you the treasures of darkness [the hoarded treasures] and the hidden riches of secret places, so that you may know that it is I, The Lord, the God of Israel, who calls you by your name.

Is 48:17 I am the Lord your God, Who teaches you to profit.

Is 54:1-3 Note, you can replace the words barren and given birth with whatever you are believing for: Shout for joy, O barren one, she who has not given birth; break forth into joyful shouting and rejoice, she who has not gone into labor [with child]! Enlarge the site of your tent [to make room for more children]; stretch out the curtains of your dwellings, do not spare them; lengthen your tent ropes and make your pegs (stakes) firm [in the ground]. For you will spread out to the right and to the left; and your descendants will take possession of nations and will inhabit deserted cities.

Is 55:5 Behold, you [Israel] shall call nations that you know not, and nations that do not know you shall run to you because of the Lord your God, and of the Holy One of Israel, for He has glorified you. Note, these nations were running to surrender to Israel and give Israel all of their wealth and resources. For our confessions, we substitute “nations” with our specific desires, such as clients/customers we don’t know, or people we don’t know...e.g. confessing “People I don’t know run to me to give me high-paying music gigs for God has glorified me.”

Is 58:8 Your righteousness will go before you [leading you to peace and prosperity], the glory of the Lord will be your rear guard.

Is 60:11 Your gates will be open continually; they shall not be shut day or night, so that people may bring to you the wealth of the nations.

Amos 9:13 “Behold, the days are coming,” says the Lord, “When the plowman shall overtake the one who gathers the harvest, and the one who treads the grapes [shall overtake] him who sows the seed [for the harvest continues until planting time]; when the mountains will drip sweet wine and all the hills shall melt [that is, everything that was once barren will overflow with streams of blessing].

Matt 8:13 It will be done for you as you have believed.

Matt 9:29 Then He touched their eyes, saying, “According to your faith [your trust and confidence in My power] it will be done to you.”

Mark 9:23 Jesus said to him, “[You say to Me,] ‘If You can?’ All things are possible for the one who believes *and* trusts [in Me]!”

Mark 11:23-24 I assure you *and* most solemnly say to you, whoever says to this mountain, ‘Be lifted up and thrown into the sea!’ and does not doubt in his heart [in God’s unlimited power], but believes that what he says is going to take place, it will be done for him [in accordance with God’s will]. For this reason I am telling you, whatever things you ask for in prayer [in accordance with God’s will], believe [with confident trust] that you have received them (as your present possession), and they will be *given* to you.

Luke 6:38 Give, and it will be given to you. They will pour into your lap a good measure - pressed down, shaken together, and running over [with no space left for more]. For with the standard of measurement you use [when you do good to others], it will be measured to you in return.

Luke 12:22-24 And [Jesus] said to His disciples, Therefore I tell you, do not be anxious *and* troubled [with cares] about your life, as to what you will [have to] eat; or about your body, as to what you will [have to] wear. For life is more than food, and the body [more] than clothes. Observe *and* consider the ravens; for they neither sow [seed] nor reap [the crop], they have neither storehouse nor barn; and [yet] God feeds them. Of how much more value are you than the birds!

Luke 12:27-28 Consider the lilies *and* wildflowers, how they grow [in the open field]. They neither labor nor spin [wool to make clothing]; yet I tell you, not even Solomon in all his glory *and* splendor dressed himself like one of these. But if this is how God clothes the grass which is in the field today and tomorrow is thrown into the furnace, how much more *will He clothe* you?

Luke 12:29-32 So as for you, do not seek what you will eat and what you will drink; nor have an anxious *and* unsettled mind. For all the [pagan] nations of the world greedily seek these things; and your [heavenly] Father [already] knows that you need them. But [strive for and actively] seek His kingdom, and these things will be given to you as well. Do not be afraid *and* anxious, little flock, for it is your Father’s good pleasure to give you the kingdom.

Luke 15:31 (prodigal son, picture of God and us) The father said to him, ‘Son, you are always with me, and all that is mine is yours.’

Luke 22:35 And He said to them, “When I sent you out without a money belt and [provision] bag and [extra] sandals, did you lack anything?” They answered, “Nothing!”

John 10:10 (Jesus speaking) I came that they may have *and* enjoy life, and have it in abundance [to the full, till it overflows]. Note, God provides so we can have enjoyment, not so we merely don’t lack.

John 11:40 Jesus said to her (Martha, before he raised Lazarus), Did I not tell you *and* promise you that if you would believe *and* rely on Me, you would see the glory of God? Note, if you are not seeing the Glory of God in a financial situation, it may be a matter of belief and reliance. If you are *only* believing and relying, it may be a matter of patience.

John 15:16 So that whatever you ask of the Father in My name [as My representative] He may give to you.

John 16:23-24 I assure you *and* most solemnly say to you, whatever you ask the Father in My name [as My representative], He will give you. Until now you have not asked [the Father] for anything in My name; but now ask *and* keep on asking and you will receive, so that your joy (gladness, delight) may be full *and* complete.

Rom 4:17 God gives life to the dead and speaks of the nonexistent things that [He has foretold and promised] as if they [already] existed. Note, we need to confess/declare things that have not happened yet in the natural as though those things have already happened.

Rom 8:32 He who did not withhold *or* spare [even] His own Son but gave Him up for us all, will He not also with Him freely *and* graciously give us all [other] things?

Rom 11:36 For from Him [all things originate] and through Him [all things live and exist] and to Him are all things [directed]. To Him be glory *and* honor forever! Amen. Note, God is our source for everything.

Rom 13:8 Keep out of debt *and* owe no man anything, except to love one another; for he who loves his neighbor [who practices loving others] has fulfilled the Law [relating to one's fellowmen, meeting all its requirements].

I Cor 2:5 So that your faith would not rest on the wisdom *and* rhetoric of men, but on the power of God.

II Cor 8:9 For you are becoming progressively acquainted with *and* recognizing more strongly *and* clearly the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ (His astonishing kindness, His gracious generosity, His undeserved favor and spiritual blessing), [in] that though He was [so very] rich, yet for your sakes He became [so very] poor, in order that by His poverty you might become enriched (abundantly supplied).

II Cor 9:6 Now [remember] this: he who sows sparingly will also reap sparingly, and he who sows generously [that blessings may come to others] will also reap generously [and be blessed].

II Cor 9:8 And God is able to make all grace (every favor and earthly blessing) come to you in abundance, so that you may always *and* under all circumstances *and* whatever the need be

self-sufficient [possessing enough to require no aid or support and furnished in abundance for every good work and charitable donation].

II Cor 9:10-11 Now He who provides seed for the sower and bread for food will provide and multiply your seed for sowing [that is, your resources] and increase the harvest of your righteousness [which shows itself in active goodness, kindness, and love]. You will be enriched in every way so that you may be generous, and this [generosity, administered] through us is producing thanksgiving to God [from those who benefit].

Eph 3:20-21 Now to Him Who, by the [action of His] power that is at work within us, is able to [carry out His purpose and] do superabundantly, far over *and* above all that we [dare] ask or think [infinitely beyond our highest prayers, desires, thoughts, hopes, or dreams] - to Him be glory in the church and in Christ Jesus throughout all generations forever and ever.

Phil 4:19 And my God will liberally supply (fill to the full) your every need according to His riches in glory in Christ Jesus.

Heb 13:5-6 Let your character *or* moral disposition be free from love of money [including greed, avarice, lust, and craving for earthly possessions] and be satisfied with your present [circumstances and with what you have]; for He [God] Himself has said, I will not in any way fail you *nor* give you up *nor* leave you without support. [I will] not, [I will] not, [I will] not in any degree leave you helpless *nor* forsake *nor* let [you] down (relax My hold on you)! [Assuredly not!] Note, scholars verifying against the original Greek manuscripts have said how this strong and emphatic wording and repeating “I will not” three times, etc. is all there, that God really wanted His assurances believed and never doubted.

I John 4:17 As He (Jesus) is, so are we in this world.

I John 5:14-15 This is the [remarkable degree of] confidence which we [as believers are entitled to] have before Him: that if we ask anything according to His will, [that is, consistent with His plan and purpose] He hears us. And if we know [for a fact, as indeed we do] that He hears *and* listens to us in whatever we ask, we [also] know [with settled and absolute knowledge] that we have [granted to us as our present possession] the requests which we have asked from Him.

III John 1:2 Beloved, I pray that in every way you may succeed *and* prosper and be in good health [physically], just as [I know] your soul prospers [spiritually].

PEACE

Ex 14:14 The Lord will fight for you while you [only need to] keep silent (hold your peace) *and* remain calm (at rest).

Ex 33:14 And the Lord said, “My presence shall go *with you*, and I will give you rest.

Josh 1:5-6 I will be with you; I will not fail you or abandon you. Be strong *and* confident and courageous.

Josh 1:9 Be strong, vigorous, and very courageous. Be not afraid, neither be dismayed (intimidated), for the Lord your God is with you wherever you go.

I Sam 30:6 But David encouraged *and* strengthened himself in the Lord his God.

I Kings 5:4 But now the Lord my God has given me rest on every side, so that there is neither adversary nor evil confronting me.

II Kings 6:16-17 Note: Elisha’s servant was afraid because he saw “horses, chariots and a great army surrounding the city.” Do not be afraid, for those who are with us are more than those who are with them. Then Elisha prayed and said, “Lord, please, open his eyes that he may see.” And the Lord opened the servant’s eyes and he saw; and behold, the mountain was full of horses and chariots of fire surrounding Elisha.

Ps 4:8 In peace [and with a tranquil heart] I will both lie down and sleep.

Ps 13:5 But I have trusted *and* relied on *and* been confident in Your lovingkindness *and* faithfulness; my heart shall rejoice *and* be in high spirits (delight) in Your salvation.

Ps 23:4 Even though I walk through the [sunless] valley of the shadow of _____ (fill in the blank with your issue), I fear no evil, for You are with me; Your rod [to protect] and Your staff [to guide], they comfort *and* console me.

Ps 27:14 Wait for *and* confidently expect the Lord; be strong (brave) and let your heart take courage (be stout and enduring); yes, wait for *and* confidently expect the Lord.

Ps 28:7-8 The Lord is my strength and my [impenetrable] shield; my heart trusts [with unwavering confidence] in Him, and I am helped; therefore my heart greatly rejoices, and with my song I shall thank Him *and* praise Him. The Lord is their [unyielding] strength, and He is the fortress of salvation to His anointed.

Ps 29:11 The Lord will give [unyielding and impenetrable] strength to His people; the Lord will bless His people with peace.

Ps 34:19 Many hardships *and* perplexing circumstances confront the righteous, but the Lord rescues him from them all.

Ps 36:7 How precious is Your steadfast love, O God! The children of men take refuge *and* put their trust under the shadow of Your wings.

Ps 37:5 Commit your way to the Lord [roll and repose each care of your load on Him]; trust (lean on, rely on, and be confident) also in Him and He will bring it to pass.

Ps 37:7-8 Be still *and* rest in the Lord; wait for Him *and* patiently lean yourself upon Him (entrust yourself to Him); do not fret (whine, agonize) because of him who prospers in his way, because of the man who brings wicked schemes to pass. Cease from anger and forsake wrath; fret not yourself - *it leads* only to evildoing.

Ps 46:10 Let be *and* be still, and know (recognize and understand) that I am God.

Ps 50:15 And call on Me in the day of trouble, I will deliver you, and you shall honor and glorify me.

Ps 55:22 Cast your burden on the Lord [release it] and He will sustain *and* uphold you; He will never allow the righteous to be shaken (slip, fall, fail).

Ps 56:3 When I am afraid, I will put my trust *and* faith in You. In God, whose word I praise; In God I have put my trust; I shall not fear.

Ps 57:1 My soul takes refuge *and* finds shelter *and* confidence (safety) in You; yes, in the shadow of Your wings will I take refuge *and* be confident until calamities *and* destructive storms are passed.

Ps 57:7 My heart is steadfast, O God, my heart is steadfast *and* confident! I will sing, yes, I will sing praises [to You]!

Ps 62:5-8 For God alone my soul waits in silence *and* quietly submits to Him, for my hope is from Him. He only is my rock and my salvation; my fortress *and* my defense, I will not be shaken *or* discouraged. On God my salvation and my glory rest; He is my rock of [unyielding] strength *and* impenetrable hardness, my refuge is in God. Trust [confidently] in, lean on, rely on, *and* have confidence in Him at all times, you people; pour out your heart before Him. God is a refuge for us (a fortress and a high tower).

Ps 91:2 I will say of the Lord, "He is my refuge and my fortress my God, in whom I trust [with great confidence, and on whom I rely]!"

Ps 112:4 Light arises in the darkness for the upright, gracious, compassionate, *and* just [who are in right standing with God].

Ps 112:7-8 He will not fear bad news; his heart is steadfast, trusting [confidently relying on and believing] in the Lord. His heart is established *and* steady, he will not be afraid while he waits to see his desire established upon his adversaries.

Ps 119:165-166 Those who love Your law have great peace; nothing makes them stumble. I hope *and* wait [with complete confidence] for Your salvation, O Lord, and I do Your commandments.

Prov 3:24-25 When you lie down, you shall not be afraid; yes, you shall lie down, and your sleep shall be sweet. Be not afraid of sudden terror *and* panic, nor of the stormy blast *or* the storm and ruin of the wicked when it comes.

Prov 16:7 The Lord makes even his enemies to be at peace with him.

Prov 3:21, 23-24 My son, let sound and godly Wisdom and understanding not escape from your sight; Then you will walk in your way securely *and* in confident trust, and you shall not dash your foot *or* stumble. When you lie down, you shall not be afraid; yes, you shall lie down, and your sleep shall be sweet.

Is 9:6-7 For to us a Child shall be born, to us a Son shall be given; and the government shall be upon His shoulder, and His name shall be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace. There shall be no end to the increase of His government and of peace. Note, Jesus is the Prince of Peace and he is abiding in us and we abide in Him.

Is 26:3 You will keep in perfect *and* constant peace *the one* whose mind is steadfast [that is, committed and focused on You—in both inclination and character], because he trusts *and* takes refuge in You [with hope and confident expectation].

Is 32:17 And the effect of righteousness will be peace [internal and external], and the result of righteousness will be quietness and confident trust forever.

Is 35:4 Say to those with an anxious *and* panic-stricken heart, be strong, fear not! Indeed, your God will come with vengeance.

Is 41:10 Fear not [there is nothing to fear], for I am with you; do not look around you in terror *and* be dismayed, for I am your God. I will strengthen *and* harden you to difficulties, yes, I will help you; yes, I will hold you up *and* retain you with My [victorious] right hand of rightness *and* justice.

Is 53:5 But He was wounded for our transgressions, He was bruised for our guilt *and* iniquities; the chastisement [needful to obtain] peace *and* well-being for us was upon Him, and with the stripes [that wounded] Him we are healed *and* made whole.

Is 54:14 You will be far from [even the thought of] oppression, for you will not fear, and from terror, for it will not come near you.

Is 55:12 For you will go out [from exile] with joy and be led forth [by the Lord Himself] with peace; the mountains and the hills will break forth into shouts of joy before you, and all the trees of the field will clap their hands.

Is 60:17 [Instead of the tyranny of the present] I will appoint peace as your officers, and righteousness your rulers.

Jer 17:7-8 [Most] blessed is the man who believes in, trusts in, *and* relies on the Lord, and whose hope *and* confidence the Lord is. For he will be [nourished] like a tree planted by the waters, that spreads out its roots by the river; and will not fear the heat when it comes; but its leaves will be green *and* moist. And it will not be anxious *and* concerned in a year of drought nor stop bearing fruit.

Daniel 10:19 O man, highly regarded *and* greatly beloved, do not be afraid. Peace be to you; take courage and be strong.

Zech 4:7 For who are you, O great mountain [of human obstacles]? You shall become a plain [a mere molehill]! With loud shoutings of the people, crying, grace, grace to it! Note, grace indicates the people didn't work for it, while they declared God's unmerited favor, the obstacle was destroyed.

Matt 10:30-31 But even the very hairs of your head are all numbered [for the Father is sovereign and has complete knowledge]. So do not fear; you are more valuable than many sparrows.

Matt 11:28 Come to Me, all you who labor and are heavy-laden *and* overburdened, and I will cause you to rest. [I will ease and relieve and refresh your souls.]

Mark 6:50 For they all saw Him (Jesus walking on the sea) and were agitated (troubled and filled with fear and dread). But immediately He talked with them and said, take heart! I Am! Stop being alarmed *and* afraid.

Mark 11:22 And Jesus said to them, have faith in God [constantly].

John 14:27 Peace I leave with you; My [perfect] peace I give to you; not as the world gives do I give to you. Do not let your heart be troubled, nor let it be afraid. [Stop allowing yourselves to be agitated and disturbed; and do not permit yourselves to be fearful and intimidated and cowardly and unsettled.] [Let My perfect peace calm you in every circumstance and give you courage and strength for every challenge.]

John 16:33 I have told you these things, so that in Me you may have [perfect] peace *and* confidence. In the world you have tribulation *and* trials *and* distress *and* frustration; but be of

good cheer [take courage; be confident, certain, undaunted, full of joy]! For I have overcome the world. [I have deprived it of power to harm you and have conquered it for you.]

John 17:15 You keep them *and* protect them from the evil one.

Rom 8:6 Now the mind of the flesh [which is sense and reason without the Holy Spirit] is death. But the mind of the [Holy] Spirit is life and [soul] peace [both now and forever].

Rom 15:13 May the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace in believing [through the experience of your faith] that by the power of the Holy Spirit you will abound in hope *and* overflow with confidence in His promises.

II Cor 12:9 He has said to me, “My grace is sufficient for you [My lovingkindness and My mercy are more than enough - always available - regardless of the situation]; for *My* strength *and* power are made perfect (fulfilled and completed) *and show themselves most effective* in [your] weakness. Therefore, I will all the more gladly glory in my weaknesses *and* infirmities, that the strength *and* power of Christ (the Messiah) may rest (yes, may pitch a tent over and completely enfold me and dwell) upon me! Note, the Greek words here are literally that God pitches a tent and dwells, with his strength and power, directly over the place in your body where you are without strength or power, or where you have danger or trouble.

Phil 4:6-7 Do not be anxious *or* worried about anything, but in everything [every circumstance and situation] by prayer and petition with thanksgiving, continue to make your [specific] requests known to God. And God’s peace [shall be yours, that peace which reassures the heart, that tranquil state of a soul assured of its salvation through Christ, and so fearing nothing from God and being content with its earthly lot of whatever sort that is, that peace] which transcends all understanding, [that peace which] shall garrison *and* stand guard over your hearts and minds in Christ Jesus [is yours].

II Pet 1:2 May grace (God’s favor) and peace (which is perfect well-being, all necessary good, all spiritual prosperity, and freedom from fears and agitating passions and moral conflicts) be multiplied to you in [the full, personal, precise, and correct] knowledge of God and of Jesus our Lord.

II Tim 1:7 For God did not give us a spirit of timidity *or* cowardice *or* fear, but [He has given us a spirit] of power and of love and of sound judgment *and* personal discipline [abilities that result in a calm, well-balanced mind and self-control].

Heb 2:18 For because He Himself [in His humanity] has suffered in being tempted (tested and tried), He is able [immediately] to run to the cry of (assist, relieve) those who are being tempted *and* tested *and* tried [and who therefore are being exposed to suffering].

Heb 4:1, 3 The promise of entering His rest still remains *and* is freely offered today. For we who believe [that is, we who personally trust and confidently rely on God] enter that rest [so we have His inner peace now because we are confident in our salvation, and assured of His power].

Heb 4:9-11 So there remains a [full and complete] Sabbath rest for the people of God. For the one who has once entered His rest has also rested from [the weariness and pain of] his [human] labors, just as God rested from [those labors uniquely] His own. Let us therefore make every effort to enter that rest [of God, to know and experience it for ourselves], so that no one will fall by *following* the same example of unbelief and disobedience [as those who died in the wilderness].

Heb 13:5-6 For He [God] Himself has said, I will not in any way fail you *nor* give you up *nor* leave you without support. [I will] not, [I will] not, [I will] not in any degree leave you helpless *nor* forsake *nor* let [you] down (relax My hold on you)! [Assuredly not!] So we take comfort *and* are encouraged *and* confidently *and* boldly say, The Lord is my Helper; I will not be seized with alarm [I will not fear or dread or be terrified].

I John 4:18 There is no fear in love [dread does not exist], but full-grown (complete, perfect) love turns fear out of doors *and* expels every trace of terror!

Rev 1:11 Saying, I am the Alpha and the Omega, the First and the Last. Note, God has the last word in everything in your life, not the doctor, judge, bank account, boss, spouse, etc.

HEALTH

Gen 6:3 My Spirit shall not strive *and* remain with man forever, because he is indeed flesh [sinful, corrupt - given over to sensual appetites]; nevertheless his days shall yet be a hundred and twenty years.

Gen 49:12 His eyes are darker *and* sparkle more than wine, and his teeth whiter than milk.

Ex 15:26 I am the Lord Who heals you.

Ex 20:12 Honor (respect, obey, care for) your father and your mother, so that your days may be prolonged in the land the Lord your God gives you.

Ex 23:25 God shall bless your bread and water, and will take sickness from your midst.

Ex 23:26 No one shall suffer miscarriage or be barren in your land; I will fulfill the number of your days.

Numb 21:8-9 And the Lord said to Moses, make a fiery serpent [of bronze] and set it on a pole; and everyone who is bitten, when he looks at it, shall live. And Moses made a serpent of bronze and put it on a pole, and if a serpent had bitten any man, when he looked to the serpent of bronze [attentively, expectantly, with a steady and absorbing gaze], he lived.

Note, the serpent on the pole is a shadow of our sin being on the cross, on Jesus, and the Israelites had to attentively, expectantly and with an absorbing gaze look on it; likewise, if we look with our mind's eye, if we think attentively, and meditate with an absorbing mindset about Jesus doing this for us on the cross and believe expectantly in Jesus' finished work on the cross we will be healed and live.

Deut 7:15 The Lord will take away from you all sickness.

Deut 11:19-21 You shall teach My words [diligently] to your children [impressing God's precepts on their minds and penetrating their hearts with His truths], speaking of them when you sit in your house and when you walk along the road and when you lie down and when you rise up. You shall write them on the doorposts of your house and on your gates, so that your days and the days of your children may be multiplied in the land which the Lord swore to your fathers to give them, as long as the heavens are above the earth.

Deut 30:19-20 I call heaven and earth as witnesses against you today, that I have set before you life and death, the blessing and the curse; therefore, you shall choose life in order that you may live, you and your descendants, by loving the Lord your God, by obeying His voice, and by holding closely to Him; for He is your life [your good life, your abundant life, your fulfillment] and the length of your days.

Deut 33:25 And as your days are (Hebrew word refers to a person's age), so will your strength, your rest *and* security be. Note, the older we get the more strength we have.

Deut 34:7 Moses was a hundred and twenty years old when he died, his eyesight was not dim, nor his natural strength abated.

Josh 14:10-11 (Caleb speaking) I am this day eighty-five years old. Yet I am as strong today as I was the day Moses sent me (age 40); as my strength was then, so is my strength now for war and to go out and to come in.

I Sam 30:6 But David encouraged *and* strengthened himself in the Lord his God.

II Kings 5:14 And his flesh was restored like that of a little child.

Job 4:4 Your words have helped the one who was stumbling to stand, and you have strengthened feeble knees.

Job 5:26 You shall come to your grave in ripe old age, and as a shock of grain goes up [to the threshing floor] in its season.

Job 33:24-25 Then [God] is gracious to him and says, Deliver him from going down into the pit [of destruction]; [Then the man's] flesh shall be restored; it becomes fresher *and* more tender than a child's; he returns to the days of his youth.

Ps 18: 32 The God who girds me with strength and makes my way perfect.

Ps 21:4 He asked life of You, *and* You gave it to him - long life.

Ps. 23:5 You have anointed *and* refreshed my head with oil. Note: In the Hebrew context this was referring to an oil that was mixed with perfume and applied on the head and gave a refreshing and invigorating sensation in a hot climate...God refreshes and invigorates us.

Ps 34:11-14 Come, you children, listen to me; I will teach you to revere *and* worshipfully fear the Lord. What man is he who desires life *and* longs for many days, that he may see good? Keep your tongue from evil and your lips from speaking deceit. Depart from evil and do good; seek, inquire for, *and* crave peace and pursue (go after) it!

Ps 34:20 He keeps all his bones; not one of them is broken.

Ps 41: 2-3 The Lord will protect him and keep him alive; the Lord will sustain, refresh *and* strengthen him on his sickbed; in his illness, You will restore him to health.

Ps 56:13 You have delivered my life from death, yes, and my feet from falling.

Ps 69:32 You who seek God, inquiring for *and* requiring Him [as your first need], let your hearts revive *and* live!

Ps 84:7 They go from strength to strength [increasing in victorious power]. Note, the older you get the stronger you get.

Ps 91:3 He will save you from the trap of the fowler, and from the deadly pestilence.

Ps 91:5-8 You shall not be afraid of the terror of the night, nor of the arrow (the evil plots and slanders of the wicked) that flies by day, nor of the pestilence that stalks in darkness, nor of the destruction *and* sudden death that surprise *and* lay waste at noonday. A thousand may fall at your side, and ten thousand at your right hand, but it shall not come near you. Only a spectator shall you be [yourself inaccessible in the secret place of the Most High].

Ps 91:9-10 Because you have made the Lord, [who is] my refuge, even the Most High, your dwelling place, no evil will befall you, nor will any plague or calamity come near your tent.

Ps 91:16 With a long life I will satisfy him and I will let him see My salvation.

Ps 92:12-13 The righteous will flourish like the date palm [long-lived, upright and useful]; they will grow like a cedar in Lebanon [majestic and stable].

Ps 92:14-15 [Growing in grace] they (the righteous) will still thrive *and* bear fruit *and* prosper in old age; they will flourish *and* be vital and fresh [rich in trust and love and contentment]; [They are living memorials] to declare that the Lord is upright *and* faithful [to His promises].

Ps 103:3-6 Bless *and* affectionately praise the Lord, O my soul, and do not forget any of His benefits; Who forgives all your sins, Who heals all your diseases; Who redeems your life from the pit, Who beautifies, dignifies and crowns you [lavishly] with lovingkindness and tender mercy; Who satisfies your years [your necessity and desire at your personal age and situation] with good things, so that your youth is renewed like the [strong, soaring, overcoming] eagle.

Ps 105:37 He brought [Israel] forth also with silver and gold, and there was not one feeble person among their tribes.

Ps 107:20 He sends forth His word and heals them and rescues them from the pit *and* destruction.

Ps 112:4 Ps 112:4 Light arises in the darkness for the upright, gracious, compassionate, *and* just [who are in right standing with God].

Ps 118:17 I will not die, but live, and declare the works *and* recount the illustrious acts of the Lord.

Ps 121:7 The Lord will protect you from all evil; He will keep your life.

Ps 127:2 It is vain for you to rise up early, to take rest late, for He gives [blessings] to His beloved in sleep.

Ps 138:8 The Lord will perfect that which concerns me.

Ps 145:14 The Lord upholds all those [of His own] who are falling and raises up all those who are bowed down.

Ps 146:8 The Lord opens *the eyes of* the blind; the Lord lifts up those who are bowed down.

Prov 3:1-2 Do not forget my teaching, but let your heart keep my commandments; for length of days and years of a life [worth living] and tranquility [inward and outward, and continuing through old age till death], these shall they (God's words and teachings) add to you.

Prov 3:7-8 Do not be wise in your own eyes; fear the Lord [with reverent awe and obedience] and turn [entirely] away from evil. It will be health to your body [your marrow, your nerves, your sinews, your muscles - all your inner parts] and refreshment (physical well-being) to your bones.

Prov 3:21, 23-24 Let sound and godly Wisdom and understanding not escape from your sight; then you will walk in your way securely *and* in confident trust, and you shall not dash your foot *or* stumble. When you lie down, you shall not be afraid; yes, you shall lie down, and your sleep shall be sweet.

Prov 4:10 Hear and accept my sayings, and the years of your life will be many.

Prov 4:22 For they (God's words) are life to those who find them, and healing *and* health to all their flesh.

Prov 6:22 When you sleep, they (the words of your God) shall keep you.

Prov 9:11 For by me [Wisdom from God] your days shall be multiplied, and the years of your life shall be increased.

Prov 12:18 There are those who speak rashly, like the piercing of a sword, but the tongue of the wise brings healing.

Prov 14:30 A calm *and* undisturbed mind *and* heart are the life *and* health of the body, but envy, jealousy, *and* wrath are like rotteness to the bones.

Prov 15:4 A soothing tongue [speaking words that build up and encourage] is a tree of life, but a perverse tongue [speaking words that overwhelm and depress] crushes the spirit.

Prov 15:30 Good news nourishes the bones.

Prov 17:22 A happy heart is good medicine *and* a cheerful mind works healing, but a broken spirit dries up the bones.

Prov 18:21 Death and life are in the power of the tongue, and they who indulge in it shall eat the fruit of it *and* bear the consequences [for death or life].

Prov 23:7 For as a man thinks in his heart, so is he. Note, thoughts have creative ability so thinking thoughts of being in perfect health should be a high priority.

Is. 35:3-7 Encourage the exhausted, and make staggering knees firm. Say to those with an anxious *and* panic-stricken heart, “Be strong, fear not! Indeed, your God will come with vengeance [for the ungodly]; the retribution of God will come, but He will save you.” Then the eyes of the blind will be opened and the ears of the deaf will be unstopped. Then the lame will leap like a deer, and the tongue of the mute will shout for joy. For waters will break forth in the wilderness and streams in the desert. And the burning sand (mirage) will become a pool [of water] and the thirsty ground springs of water. Note, speak encouragement to those with health issues and declare God’s finished works (He has already come and saved us). Also, water represents the Spirit of God having an effect in humans.

Is 40:29 He gives power to the faint *and* weary, and to him who has no might He increases strength [causing it to multiply and making it to abound].

Is 40:30-31 Even youths grow weary and tired, and vigorous young men stumble badly, but those who wait for the Lord [who expect, look for, and hope in Him] will gain new strength *and* renew their power; they will lift up their wings [and rise up close to God] like eagles [rising toward the sun]; they will run and not become weary, they will walk and not grow tired.

Is 53:4 But [in fact] He has borne our griefs (sicknesses, weaknesses, and distresses), and He has carried our sorrows *and* pains; yet we [ignorantly] assumed that He was stricken, struck down by God and degraded *and* humiliated [by Him].

Is 53:5 But He was wounded for our transgressions, He was crushed for our wickedness [our sin, our injustice, our wrongdoing]; the punishment [required] for our well-being *fell* on Him, and by His stripes (wounds) we are healed *and* made whole.

Is 58:8 Then shall your light break forth like the morning, and your healing (your restoration and the power of a new life) shall spring forth speedily; your righteousness (your rightness, your justice, and your right relationship with God) shall go before you [leading you to peace and prosperity], and the glory of the Lord shall be your rear guard.

Jer 30:17 For I will restore health to you and I will heal your wounds, says the Lord.

Joel 3:10 Let the weak say, “I am strong!”

Malachi 4:2 But unto you who revere *and* worshipfully fear My name shall the Sun of Righteousness arise with healing in His wings *and* His beams, and you shall go forth and gambol like calves [released] from the stall *and* leap for joy.

Matt 4:23 And He went about all Galilee, teaching in their synagogues and preaching the good news (Gospel) of the kingdom, and healing every disease and every weakness *and* infirmity among the people.

Matt 4:24 And they brought to Him all who were sick, those suffering with various diseases and pains, those under the power of demons, and epileptics, paralytics; and He healed them.

Matt 8:13 It shall be done for you as you have believed.

Matt 8:16-17 They brought to Him many who were under the power of demons, and He drove out the spirits with a word and restored to health all who were sick. And thus He fulfilled what was spoken by the prophet Isaiah, He Himself took [in order to carry away] our weaknesses *and* infirmities and bore away our diseases.

Matt 9:29 Then He touched their eyes, saying, “According to your faith [your trust and confidence in My power and My ability to heal] it will be done to you.”

Matt 9:35 Jesus went throughout all the cities and villages, teaching in their synagogues and proclaiming the good news (gospel) of the kingdom, and healing every kind of disease and every kind of sickness [His words and His works reflecting His Messiahship].

Matt 12:15 Many followed Him, and He healed all of them [who were sick].

Matt 15:31 So that the crowd was amazed when they saw the mute speaking, the maimed made whole, the lame walking, and the blind seeing; and they recognized *and* praised *and* thanked *and* glorified the God of Israel.

Mark 9:23 Jesus said to him, “[You say to Me,] ‘If You can?’ All things are possible for the one who believes *and* trusts [in Me]!”

Mark 11:22-23 Jesus replied, have faith in God [constantly]. I assure you *and* most solemnly say to you, whoever says to this mountain, ‘Be lifted up and thrown into the sea!’ and does not doubt in his heart [in God’s unlimited power], but believes that what he says is going to take place, it will be done for him .

Mark 16:17-18 And these attesting signs will accompany those who believe: in My name they will drive out demons; they will speak in new languages; they will pick up serpents; and [even] if they drink anything deadly, it will not hurt them; they will lay their hands on the sick, and they will get well.

Luke 4:18-19 The Spirit of the Lord [is] upon Me, because He has anointed Me [the Anointed One, the Messiah] to preach the good news (the Gospel) to the poor; He has sent Me to announce release to the captives and recovery of sight to the blind, to send forth as delivered those who are oppressed [who are downtrodden, bruised, crushed, and broken down by calamity], to proclaim the accepted *and* acceptable year of the Lord [the day when salvation and the free favors of God profusely abound].

Luke 5:17 The power of the Lord was present with Jesus to heal them. Note, this same power is present in us now.

Luke 8:50 But Jesus answered him, Do not be seized with alarm *or* struck with fear; simply believe [in Me as able to do this], and she shall be made well.

Luke 10:19 Listen carefully: I have given you authority *and* power [that you now possess] to tread on serpents and scorpions, and [physical and mental strength and the ability to exercise authority] over all the power of the enemy (Satan); and nothing will [in any way] harm you.

Luke 17:19 Jesus said to him, “Get up and go [on your way]. Your faith [your personal trust in Me and your confidence in God’s power] has restored you to health.”

Luke 21:18 But not a hair of your head will perish.

John 6:63 (Jesus speaking) It is the Spirit Who gives life [He is the Life-giver]; the flesh conveys no benefit whatever [there is no profit in it]. The words (truths) that I have been speaking to you are spirit and life.

John 11:40 Jesus said to her (Martha before raising Lazarus), Did I not tell you *and* promise you that if you would believe *and* rely on Me, you would see the glory of God? Note, if you are not seeing the Glory of God in a situation, it may be a matter of belief and reliance. If you are only believing and relying, it may be a matter of patience.

John 14:12 I assure you *and* most solemnly say to you, anyone who believes in Me [as Savior] will also do the things that I do; and he will do even greater things than these [in extent and outreach], because I am going to the Father.

John 16:33 I have told you these things, so that in Me you may have [perfect] peace. In the world you have tribulation *and* distress *and* suffering, but be courageous [be confident, be undaunted, be filled with joy]; I have overcome the world.” [My conquest is accomplished, My victory abiding.]

John 17:15 You will keep *and* protect them from the evil one.

Acts 2:24 But God raised Him up, releasing Him *and* bringing an end to the agony of death, since it was impossible for Him to be held in death's power. Note, Jesus has defeated death and every single other sickness that could affect us.

Acts 3:16 And His name, through *and* by faith in His name, has made this man whom you see and recognize well *and* strong. [Yes] the faith which is through *and* by Him [Jesus] has given the man this perfect soundness [of body] before all of you.

Acts 9:34 And Peter said to him, Aeneas, Jesus Christ (the Messiah) [now] makes you whole. Get up and make your bed! And immediately [Aeneas] stood up.

Acts 27:34 So I urge you to eat some food, for this is for your survival; for not a hair from the head of any of you will perish.

Rom 4:17 God gives life to the dead and speaks of the nonexistent things that [He has foretold and promised] as if they [already] existed. Note, we need to confess/declare and believe things that are not as though they already are.

Rom 4:19-21 He did not weaken in faith (Abraham) when he considered the [utter] impotence of his own body, which was as good as dead because he was about a hundred years old, or [when he considered] the barrenness of Sarah's [deadened] womb. No unbelief *or* distrust made him waver (doubtingly question) concerning the promise of God, but he grew strong *and* was empowered by faith as he gave praise *and* glory to God, fully satisfied *and* assured that God was able *and* mighty to keep His word *and* to do what He had promised.

Rom 8:2-3, 7 For the law of the Spirit of life [which is] in Christ Jesus [the law of our new being] has set you free from the law of sin and of death. For what the Law could not do [that is, overcome sin and remove its penalty, its power] being weakened by the flesh [man's nature without the Holy Spirit], God did: He sent His own Son in the likeness of sinful man as an offering for sin. And He condemned sin in the flesh [subdued it and overcame it in the person of His own Son] (Note, sickness was part of the curse of not obeying the law, that penalty has been removed, overcome, subdued.) The mind of the flesh [with its carnal thoughts and purposes] is hostile to God, for it does not submit itself to God's Law; indeed it cannot.

Note Your flesh (body, unrenewed mind, emotions) literally cannot submit itself to the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus, so don't look to your body or your natural mind to tell you if you are healed, get in the Spirit realm and the word to find out the status of your health and come into agreement with them, not your flesh, which profiteth nothing and is death. I Cor 2:14 But the natural man does not accept the things [the teachings and revelations] of the Spirit of God, for they are foolishness [absurd and illogical] to him; and he is incapable of understanding them, because they are spiritually discerned *and* appreciated, [and he is unqualified to judge spiritual matters].

Rom 8:6 Now the mind of the flesh [which is sense and reason without the Holy Spirit] is death. But the mind of the [Holy] Spirit is life and [soul] peace [both now and forever].

Rom 8:11 And if the Spirit of Him who raised Jesus from the dead lives in you, He who raised Christ Jesus from the dead will also give life to your mortal bodies through His Spirit, who lives in you.

I Cor 2:5 So that your faith would not rest on the wisdom *and* rhetoric of men, but on the power of God.

I Cor 7:4 The wife does not have [exclusive] authority over her own body, but the husband *shares with her*; and likewise the husband does not have [exclusive] authority over his body, but the wife *shares with him*. Note, use your authority over your spouse's body to command sickness and infirmities to go and wholeness to manifest.

II Cor 12:9-10 But He said to me, My grace (My favor and loving-kindness and mercy) is enough for you [sufficient against any danger and enables you to bear the trouble manfully]; for *My* strength *and* power are made perfect (fulfilled and completed) *and show themselves most effective* in [your] weakness. Therefore, I will all the more gladly glory in my weaknesses *and* infirmities, that the strength *and* power of Christ (the Messiah) may rest (yes, may pitch a tent over and dwell) upon me! So for the sake of Christ, I am well pleased *and* take pleasure in infirmities, insults, hardships, persecutions, perplexities *and* distresses; for when I am weak in human strength], then am I [truly] strong (able, powerful in divine strength).

Eph 5:29 For no one ever hated his own body, but [instead] he nourishes *and* protects and cherishes it, just as Christ does the church, because we are members (parts) of His body. Note, healthy living is biblical, nourish and protect your body, just don't put your faith in those pursuits. Also, Jesus nourishes and protects and cherishes the church, and we are the church.

Eph 6:10 Be strong in the Lord [be empowered through your union with Him]; draw your strength from Him [that strength which His boundless might provides].

I Thes 5:16-18 Rejoice always *and* delight in your faith; be unceasing *and* persistent in prayer; in every situation [no matter what the circumstances] be thankful *and* continually give thanks *to God*; for this is the will of God for you in Christ Jesus.

I Thes 5:23-24 Now may the God of peace Himself sanctify you through and through [that is, separate you from profane and vulgar things, make you pure and whole and undamaged - consecrated to Him - set apart for His purpose]; and may your spirit and soul and body be kept complete.

Hebrews 2:14 Therefore, since [these His] children share in flesh and blood [the physical nature of mankind], He Himself in a similar manner also shared in the same [physical nature, but without sin], so that through [experiencing] death He might make powerless (ineffective, impotent) him who had the power of death - that is, the devil. Note, the devil no longer has the power of death or sickness or anything else that leads to death.

Heb 13:5-6 For He [God] Himself has said, I will not in any way fail you *nor* give you up *nor* leave you without support. [I will] not, [I will] not, [I will] not in any degree leave you helpless *nor* forsake *nor* let [you] down (relax My hold on you)! [Assuredly not!] So we take comfort *and* are encouraged *and* confidently *and* boldly say, The Lord is my Helper; I will not be seized with alarm [I will not fear or dread or be terrified]. Note, scholars verifying against the original Greek manuscripts have said how this strong and emphatic wording and repeating “I will not” three times, etc. is all there, God really wanted His assurances believed and never doubted.

I Pet 2:24 He personally carried our sins in His body on the cross [willingly offering Himself on it, as on an altar of sacrifice], so that we might die to sin [becoming immune from the penalty and power of sin] and live for righteousness; for by His wounds you [who believe] have been healed.

I Pet 3:10-11 Let him who wants to enjoy (love) life and see good days [good - whether apparent or not] keep his tongue free from evil and his lips from guile (treachery, deceit). Let him turn away from wickedness *and* shun it, and let him do right. Let him search for peace (harmony; undisturbedness from fears, agitating passions, and moral conflicts) and seek it eagerly. [Do not merely desire peaceful relations with God, with your fellowmen, and with yourself, but pursue, go after them!]

I John 4:17 As He is, so are we in this world.

III John 1:2 Beloved, I pray that in every way you may succeed *and* prosper and be in good health [physically], just as [I know] your soul prospers [spiritually].

Rev 1:11 Saying, *I am the Alpha and the Omega, the First and the Last*. Note, God has the last word in everything in your life, not the doctor, judge, bank account, boss, spouse, etc.

Rev 21:5 And He who sits on the throne said, “Behold, I am making all things new.” Note, this includes body parts.

PATH/ORDER STEPS/PLANS

Job 23:14 For He performs what is planned (appointed) for me, and He is mindful of many such things.

Ps 16:11 You will show me the path of life; in Your presence is fullness of joy; in Your right hand there are pleasures forevermore.

Ps 18:28 The Lord my God illuminates my darkness.

Ps 18:30 As for God, His way is perfect!

Ps 18: 32-33 The God who girds me with strength and makes my way perfect. He makes my feet like hinds' feet [able to stand firmly or make progress on the dangerous heights of testing and trouble]; He sets me securely upon my high places.

Ps 23:1 The Lord is my Shepherd [to feed, to guide and to shield me].

Ps 23:2-3 He makes me lie down in [fresh, tender] green pastures; He leads me beside the still *and* restful waters. He refreshes *and* restores my life (my self); He leads me in the paths of righteousness [uprightness and right standing with Him - not for my earning it, but] for His name's sake. Note, in David's time a path of righteousness was the common term for the sheep's path that would take one directly to the top of the hill, and the common term for the very top of a hill was the same as the Hebrew word for hope, a confident expectation.

Ps 27:11 Teach me Your way, O Lord, and lead me in a plain *and* even path

Ps 32:8 I [the Lord] will instruct you and teach you in the way you should go; I will counsel you with My eye upon you.

Ps 37:23 The steps of a [good] man are directed *and* established by the Lord when He delights in his way [and He busies Himself with his every step].

Ps 37:31 Not one of his steps will slip.

Ps 40:17 The Lord takes thought *and* plans for me.

Ps 43:3 O send out Your light and Your truth, let them lead me.

Ps 57:2 I will cry to God Most High, Who performs on my behalf *and* rewards me [Who brings to pass His purposes for me and surely completes them]!

Ps 85:13 Righteousness will go before Him and will make His footsteps into a way [in which to walk].

Ps 97:11 Light is sown [like seed] for the righteous *and* illuminates their path.

Ps 112:4 Light arises in the darkness for the upright.

Ps 119:133 Establish my steps *and* direct them by [means of] Your word.

Ps 139:9-10 If I take the wings of the morning or dwell in the uttermost parts of the sea, even there shall Your hand lead me, and Your right hand shall hold me.

Ps 143:10 Let Your good Spirit lead me on level ground. Note, my path will be flat, smooth, easy to walk on if I follow the leading of the Spirit.

Prov 2:9 Then you will understand righteousness, justice, and fair dealing [in every area and relation]; yes, you will understand every good path.

Prov 3:5-6 Lean on, trust in, and be confident in the Lord with all your heart and mind and do not rely on your own insight or understanding. In all your ways know *and* acknowledge *and* recognize Him, and He will direct your paths and make your paths straight *and* smooth [removing obstacles that block your way].

Prov 4:18 But the path of the just (righteous) is like the light of dawn, that shines brighter and brighter until [it reaches its full strength and glory in] the perfect day [to be prepared].

Prov 6:22 When you go, they [the words of your parents' God] shall lead you; when you sleep, they shall keep you; and when you waken, they shall talk with you.

Prov 16:3 Roll your works upon the Lord [commit and trust them wholly to Him; He will cause your thoughts to become agreeable to His will, and] so shall your plans be established *and* succeed.

Prov 16:9 A man's mind plans his way [as he journeys through life], but the Lord directs his steps *and* establishes them.

Prov 20:24 Man's steps are ordered *and* ordained by the Lord. How then can a man [fully] understand his way?

Prov 23:7 For as a man thinks in his heart, so is he. Note, thoughts have creative ability so thinking thoughts of being successful in everything we put our hand to should be a high priority.

Is 43:18-19 Do not remember the former things, or ponder the things of the past. Listen carefully, I am about to do a new thing, now it will spring forth; will you not be aware of it? I will even put a road in the wilderness, rivers in the desert.

Is 48:17 I am the Lord your God, who teaches you to profit (benefit), Who leads you in the way that you should go.

Is 58:11 And the Lord will continually guide you, and satisfy your soul in scorched *and* dry places, and give strength to your bones; and you will be like a watered garden, and like a spring of water whose waters do not fail.

Jer 29:11 For I know the plans *and* thoughts that I have for you, says the Lord, plans for peace *and* well-being and not for disaster, to give you a future and a hope.

Jer 31:9 I will cause them to walk by streams of water and bring them in a straight way in which they will not stumble.

Romans 8:28 And we know [with great confidence] that God [who is deeply concerned about us] causes all things to work together [as a plan] for good for those who love God, to those who are called according to His plan *and* purpose.

Ephesians 2:10 For we are God's (own) handiwork (His workmanship), recreated in Christ Jesus, born anew that we may do those good works which God predestined (planned beforehand) for us, taking paths which He prepared ahead of time, that we should walk in them, living the good life which He prearranged and made ready for us to live.

Phil 1:6 He Who began a good work in you will continue until the day of Jesus Christ [right up to the time of His return], developing [that good work] *and* perfecting *and* bringing it to full completion in you.

Heb 13:20-21 Now may the God of peace [the source of serenity and spiritual well-being] who brought up from the dead our Lord Jesus, the great Shepherd of the sheep, through the blood *that sealed and ratified* the eternal covenant, equip you with every good thing to carry out His will *and* strengthen you [making you complete and perfect as you ought to be], accomplishing in us that which is pleasing in His sight, through Jesus Christ.

James 1:2-4 Consider it nothing but joy, my brothers and sisters, whenever you fall into various trials. Be assured that the testing of your faith [through experience] produces endurance [leading to spiritual maturity, and inner peace]. And let endurance have its perfect result *and* do a thorough work, so that you may be perfect and completely developed [in your faith], lacking in nothing. Note, being joyful in trials ultimately leads to no lack. There are people who hold a "Count It All Joy Party" whenever they encounter a trial, with a cake and celebrate that their faith will be proven, and their endurance and steadfastness and patience are increasing and they lack nothing.

Rev 3:8 I have set before you a door wide open which no one is able to shut.

BATTLES/ENEMIES

Gen 50:20 As for you, you meant evil against me, but God meant it for good in order to bring about this present outcome.

Ex 14:14 The Lord will fight for you while you [only need to] keep silent *and* remain calm.

Ex 23:22 I will be an enemy to your enemies and an adversary to your adversaries.

Deut 7:18-19 You shall not be afraid of them; you shall remember [with confidence] what the Lord your God did to Pharaoh and to all Egypt - the great trials which you saw with your own eyes, and the signs, the wonders, the mighty hand and the outstretched arm by which the Lord your God brought you out.

Deut 7:21 You shall not dread them, for the Lord your God is in your midst, a great and awesome God.

Deut 7:23 But the Lord your God will hand them over to you, and will confuse them with a great panic until they are destroyed.

Deut 28:7 The Lord shall cause your enemies who rise up against you to be defeated before your face; they shall come out against you one way and flee before you seven ways.

Deut 28:13 The Lord will make you the head (leader) and not the tail (follower); and you will be above only, and you will not be beneath.

Josh 1:5-6 No man will [be able to] stand before you [to oppose you] as long as you live. Just as I was [present] with Moses, so will I be with you; I will not fail you or abandon you. Be strong *and* confident and courageous.

Josh 1:9 Have not I commanded you? Be strong, vigorous, and very courageous. Be not afraid, neither be dismayed, for the Lord your God is with you wherever you go.

I Sam 2:9 He will guard the feet of His godly ones, but the wicked shall be silenced *and* perish in darkness; for by strength shall no man prevail.

I Kings 5:4 But now that the Lord my God has given me rest [from war] on every side, there is neither adversary nor misfortune [confronting me].

II Kings 6:16-17 Note: Elisha's servant was afraid because he saw "horses, chariots and a great army surrounding the city." Do not be afraid; for those with us are more than those with them. Then Elisha prayed, Lord, I pray You, open his eyes that he may see. And the Lord opened the young man's eyes, and he saw, and behold, the mountain was full of horses and chariots of fire surrounding Elisha.

II Chron 20:12 O our God, will You not judge them? For we are powerless against this great multitude which is coming against us. We do not know what to do, but our eyes are on You.

II Chron 20:15 The Lord says this to you: Be not afraid or dismayed at this great multitude, for the battle is not yours, but God's.

II Chron 20:17 You shall not need to fight in this battle; take your positions, stand still, and see the deliverance of the Lord [Who is] with you. Fear not nor be dismayed. Note: when you handle adversity this way, then a result like II Chron 20:25 can take place..so many goods, garments and precious things they were three days in gathering the spoils...God fights the battles, we collect the spoils for 3 days and have a parade feast on a banquet in front of our enemies too!

Job 8:20-22 Behold, God will not reject a *man of integrity*, nor will He strengthen *or* support evildoers. He will yet fill your mouth with laughter and your lips with joyful shouting [if you are found blameless]. Those who hate you will be clothed with shame, and the tents of the wicked will be no longer."

Job 22: 29-30 When you are cast down *and* humbled, you will speak with confidence, and the humble person He will lift up *and* save. He will even rescue the one [for whom you intercede] who is not innocent; and he will be rescued through the cleanness of your hands.

Ps 10:17-18 O Lord, You have heard the desire *and* the longing of the humble *and* oppressed; You will prepare *and* strengthen *and* direct their hearts, You will cause Your ear to hear, to do justice to the fatherless and the oppressed, so that man, who is of the earth, may not terrify them any more.

Ps 13:5 But I have trusted, leaned on, *and* been confident in Your mercy *and* loving-kindness; my heart shall rejoice *and* be in high spirits in Your salvation.

Ps 18:2-3 The Lord is my rock, my fortress, and the One who rescues me; My God, my rock *and* strength in whom I trust *and* take refuge; My shield, and the horn of my salvation, my high tower - my stronghold. I call upon the Lord, who is worthy to be praised; and I am saved from my enemies.

Ps 18:16-17 He reached from on high, He took me; He drew me out of many waters. He rescued me from my strong enemy.

Ps 18: 30 He is a shield to all who take refuge in Him.

Ps 18: 48 Who delivers me from my enemies; yes, You lift me up above those who rise up against me; You deliver me from the man of violence.

Ps 20: 7 Some trust in *and* boast of chariots and some of horses, but we will trust in *and* boast of the name of the Lord our God.

Ps 23:5 You prepare a banquet table before me in the presence of my enemies.

Ps. 27:1-3 The Lord is my light and my salvation - whom shall I fear? The Lord is the refuge *and* fortress of my life - whom shall I dread? When the wicked came against me to eat up my flesh, my adversaries and my enemies, they stumbled and fell. Though an army encamp against me, my heart will not fear; though war arise against me, even in this I am confident.

Ps 27:5-6 For in the day of trouble He will hide me in His shelter; in the secret place of His tent will He hide me; He will set me high upon a rock. And now shall my head be lifted up above my enemies round about me; in His tent I will offer sacrifices *and* shouting of joy; I will sing, yes, I will sing praises to the Lord.

Ps 33:5 He loves righteousness and justice; the earth is full of the loving-kindness of the Lord.

Ps 34:17 When *the righteous* cry [for help], the Lord hears and rescues them from all their distress *and* troubles.

Ps 34:19 Many hardships *and* perplexing circumstances confront the righteous, but the Lord rescues him from them all.

Ps 37:7-8 Be still *and* rest in the Lord; wait for Him *and* patiently lean yourself upon Him; fret not yourself because of him who prospers in his way, because of the man who brings wicked devices to pass. Cease from anger and forsake wrath; fret not yourself - it tends only to evildoing.

Ps 37:28 For the Lord delights in justice and does not abandon His saints (faithful ones).

Ps 40:13-15 Be pleased, O Lord, to save me; O Lord, make haste to help me. Let those be ashamed and humiliated together who seek my life to destroy it; let those be turned back [in defeat] and dishonored who delight in my hurt. Let them be appalled and desolate because of their shame who say to me, Aha, aha [rejoicing in my misfortune]!

Ps 40:17 You are my Help and my Deliverer. O my God.

Ps 41:12 You (God) do not hand him over to the desire of his enemies.

Ps 46:10 Be still and know (recognize, understand) that I am God.

Ps 50:15 Call on Me in the day of trouble; I will rescue you, and you shall honor *and* glorify Me.

Ps 54:4 Behold, God is my helper *and* ally; the Lord is my upholder *and* is with them who uphold my life.

Ps 54:7 For He has rescued me from every trouble, and my eye has looked *with satisfaction* (triumph) on my enemies.

Ps 55:18 He has redeemed my life in peace from the battle that was against me [so that none came near me], for they were many against me.

Ps 57:2 I will cry to God Most High, Who performs on my behalf *and* rewards me.

Ps 63:11 For the mouths of those who speak lies will be stopped.

Ps 64:7-8 But God will shoot an unexpected arrow at them; and suddenly shall they be wounded. And they will be made to stumble, their own tongues turning against them; all who gaze upon them will shake their heads *and* flee away.

Ps 72:14 He will redeem their life from oppression *and* fraud and violence.

Ps 89:14 Righteousness and justice are the foundation of Your throne; mercy *and* loving-kindness and truth go before Your face.

Ps 103:6 The Lord executes righteousness *and* justice [not for me only, but] for all who are oppressed.

Ps 112:4 Light arises in the darkness for the upright, gracious, compassionate, *and* just [who are in right standing with God].

Ps 119:151 You are near, O Lord [nearer to me than my foes].

Ps 119:165 Nothing shall offend them *or* make them stumble. Note, don't take offense, ever!

Ps 138:7 Though I walk in the midst of trouble, You will revive me; You will stretch forth Your hand against the wrath of my enemies, and Your right hand will save me.

Ps 146:9 The way of the wicked He makes crooked (turns upside down and brings to ruin).

Prov 2:10-12 For skillful *and* godly Wisdom shall enter into your heart, and knowledge shall be pleasant to you. Discretion shall watch over you, understanding shall keep you, to deliver you from the way of evil *and* the evil men, from men who speak perverse things *and* are liars.

Prov 12:21 No [actual] evil, misfortune, *or* calamity shall come upon the righteous, but the wicked shall be filled with evil, misfortune, *and* calamity.

Prov 17:9 He who covers *and* forgives an offense seeks love, but he who repeats *or* harps on a matter separates even close friends.

Prov 19:11 Good sense *and* discretion make a man slow to anger, and it is his honor *and* glory to overlook a transgression *or* an offense [without seeking revenge and harboring resentment].

Prov 21:3 To do righteousness and justice is more acceptable to the Lord than sacrifice [for wrongs repeatedly committed].

Prov 22:8 He who sows injustice will reap [a harvest of] trouble, and the rod of his wrath [with which he oppresses others] will fail.

Prov 23:7 For as a man thinks in his heart, so is he. Note, thoughts have creative ability so thinking thoughts of being a victory and what our enemy's life would be like if they were truly blessed and happy should be a high priority.

Prov 24:16 For a righteous man falls seven times, and rises again, but the wicked stumble in *time of* disaster *and* collapse.

Prov 24:17 Do not rejoice *and* gloat when your enemy falls, and do not let your heart be glad [in self-righteousness] when he stumbles.

Prov 24:19-20 Do not get upset because of evildoers, or be envious of the wicked, for there will be no future for the evil man.

Prov 29:25 The fear of man brings a snare, but whoever trusts in *and* puts his confidence in the Lord will be exalted *and* safe.

Is 40:23 Who brings dignitaries to nothing, Who makes the judges *and* rulers of the earth as chaos (emptiness, falsity, and futility), useless (meaningless).

Is 41:11-13 Behold, all they who are enraged *and* inflamed against you shall be put to shame and humiliated; they who strive against you shall be as nothing and shall perish. You shall search for those who contend with you but shall not find them; they who war against you shall be as nothing, as nothing at all. For I the Lord your God hold your right hand; I am the Lord, Who says to you, Fear not; I will help you!

Is 54:15 Behold, they may gather together and stir up strife, but it is not from Me. If anyone fiercely attacks you it will not be from Me. Whoever attacks you will fall because of you.

Is 59:19 When the enemy shall come in like a flood the Spirit of the Lord will lift up a standard against him *and* put him to flight [for He will come like a rushing stream which the breath of the Lord drives, overwhelming the enemy].

Is 61:6-8 You shall eat the wealth of the nations, and the glory [once that of your captors] shall be yours. Instead of your [former] shame you shall have a twofold recompense; instead of dishonor *and* reproach [your people] shall rejoice in their portion. Therefore in their land they shall possess double [what they had forfeited]; everlasting joy shall be theirs. For I the Lord love justice; I hate robbery *and* wrong.

Jer 1:8 Do not be afraid of them [or their hostile faces], for I am with you [always] to protect you *and* deliver you, says the Lord.

Jer 1:19 They will fight against you, but they will not [ultimately] prevail over you, for I am with you [always] to protect you *and* deliver you,” says the Lord.

Micah 7:8 Do not rejoice over me [amid my tragedies], O my enemy! Though I fall, I will rise; though I sit in the darkness [of distress], the Lord is a light for me.

Zech 4:7 What are you, O great mountain [of human obstacles]? Before Zerubbabel [who will rebuild the temple] *you will become* a plain (insignificant)!

Matt 10:26 So have no fear of them; for nothing is concealed that will not be revealed, or kept secret that will not become known.

Mark 11:22-23 Jesus replied, “Have faith in God [constantly]. I assure you *and* most solemnly say to you, whoever says to this mountain, ‘Be lifted up and thrown into the sea!’ and does not doubt in his heart [in God’s unlimited power], but believes that what he says is going to take place, it will be done for him.

Luke 18:7-8 And will not [our just] God defend *and* protect *and* avenge His elect (His chosen ones), who cry to Him? Will He defer them *and* delay help on their behalf? I tell you, He will defend *and* protect *and* avenge them speedily.

Luke 21:15 For I, Myself, will give you [skillful] words and wisdom that all of your foes combined will be unable to resist or refute.

Rom 8:28 And we know [with great confidence] that God [who is deeply concerned about us] causes all things to work together [as a plan] for good to and for those who love God, to those who are called according to His plan *and* purpose.

Rom 8:31 What then shall we say to all these things? If God is for us, who can be [successful] against us[Who can be our foe, if God is on our side]?

Rom 8:37 Yet in all these things (note, the “things” listed in verse 35 are tribulation, distress, persecution, famine, nakedness, danger, or sword) we are more than conquerors *and* gain an overwhelming victory through Him who loved us [so much that He died for us].

Rom 12:14 Bless those who persecute you [who cause you harm or hardship]; bless and do not curse [them].

Rom 12:16 Live in harmony with one another; do not be haughty (snobbish, high-minded, exclusive), but readily adjust yourself to [people, things] *and* give yourselves to humble tasks. Never overestimate yourself *or* be wise in your own conceits.

Rom 12:17-18 Never repay anyone evil for evil. Take thought for what is right *and* gracious *and* proper in the sight of everyone. If possible, as far as it depends on you, live at peace with everyone.

Rom 12:19 Beloved, never avenge yourselves, but leave the way open for God’s wrath [and His judicial righteousness]; for it is written [in Scripture], “Vengeance is Mine, I will repay,” says the Lord.

II Cor 2:14 But thanks be to God, Who in Christ always leads us in triumph [as trophies of Christ’s victory] and through us spreads *and* makes evident the fragrance of the knowledge of God everywhere.

Eph 4:29 Let no foul *or* polluting language, *nor* evil word *nor* unwholesome *or* worthless talk [ever] come out of your mouth, but only such [speech] as is good *and* beneficial to the spiritual progress of others, as is fitting to the need *and* the occasion, that it may be a blessing *and* give grace (God’s favor) to those who hear it.

Eph 4:32 And become useful *and* helpful *and* kind to one another, tenderhearted (compassionate, understanding, loving-hearted), forgiving one another [readily and freely], as God in Christ forgave you.

Phil 1:28 And in no way be alarmed *or* intimidated [in anything] by your opponents, for such [constancy and fearlessness on your part] is a [clear] sign [a proof and a seal] for them of [their impending] destruction, but [a clear sign] for you of deliverance *and* salvation, and that *too*, from God. Note, if we stand constant in God’s truths, and fearless, that is a sign to Satan he will fail, and that overcomes him.

I Thes 5:16-18 Rejoice always *and* delight in your faith; be unceasing *and* persistent in prayer; in every situation [no matter what the circumstances] be thankful *and* continually give thanks *to* God; for this is the will of God for you in Christ Jesus.

Heb 13:5-6 For He has said, “I will never [under any circumstances] desert you [nor give you up nor leave you without support, nor will I in any degree leave you helpless], nor will I forsake *or* let you down *or* relax My hold on you[assuredly not]!” So we take comfort *and* are encouraged

and confidently say, “The Lord is my Helper [in time of need], I will not be afraid. What will man do to me?”

James 1:2-3 Consider it nothing but joy, my brothers and sisters, whenever you fall into various trials. Be assured that the testing of your faith [through experience] produces endurance [leading to spiritual maturity, and inner peace]. And let endurance have its perfect result *and* do a thorough work, so that you may be perfect and completely developed [in your faith], lacking in nothing. There are people who hold a “Consider It Pure Joy Party” whenever they encounter a trial, with a cake and candles and celebrate that their faith will be proven, and their endurance and steadfastness and patience are increasing and they will lack nothing.

James 1:20 For man’s anger does not promote the righteousness God [wishes and requires].

I Pet 2:15 For it is God’s will *and* intention that by doing right [your good and honest lives] should silence (muzzle, gag) the ignorant charges *and* ill-informed criticisms of foolish persons.

I Pet 3:9-12 Never return evil for evil or insult for insult [avoid scolding, berating, and any kind of abuse], but on the contrary, give a blessing [pray for one another’s well-being, contentment, and protection and truly pitying and loving them]; for you have been called for this very purpose, that you might inherit a blessing [from God that brings well-being, happiness, and protection]. For let him who wants to enjoy life and see good days [good—whether apparent or not] keep his tongue free from evil and his lips from guile (treachery, deceit). Let him turn away from wickedness *and* shun it, and let him do right. Let him search for peace (harmony; undisturbedness from fears, agitating passions, and moral conflicts) and seek it eagerly. [Do not merely desire peaceful relations with God, with your fellowmen, and with yourself, but pursue, go after them!]. For the eyes of the Lord are [looking favorably] upon the righteous (those who are upright and in right standing with God), and His ears are attentive to their prayer. But the face of the Lord is against those who practice evil [to oppose them, to frustrate, and defeat them].

I Pet 3:17 For it is better that you suffer [unjustly] for doing what is right, if that should be God’s will, than [to suffer justly] for doing wrong.

I John 5:4-5 For everyone born of God is victorious *and* overcomes the world; and this is the victory that has conquered *and* overcome the world—our [continuing, persistent] faith [in Jesus the Son of God]. Who is the one who is victorious *and* overcomes the world? It is the one who believes *and* recognizes the fact that Jesus is the Son of God.

SAFETY

Ex 23:20 Behold, I send an Angel before you to keep *and* guard you on the way and to bring you to the place I have prepared.

Ex 23:26 I will fulfill the number of your days.

Deut 33:25 As your days are (note, Hebrew for the older you get), so will your strength, your rest *and* security be.

Job 5:20, 22 In famine He will redeem you from death, and in war from the power of the sword. You will laugh at violence and famine, and you will not be afraid of the wild beasts of the earth.

Job 5:24 You will know also that your tent is secure *and* at peace, and you will visit your dwelling and fear no loss [nor find anything amiss].

Ps 23:1 The Lord is my Shepherd [to feed, guide, and shield me].

Ps 34:7 The Angel of the Lord encamps around those who fear Him [who revere and worship Him with awe] and each of them He delivers.

Ps 41:2 The Lord will protect him and keep him alive; and he will be called blessed in the land.

Ps 72:13-14 And he will save the lives of the needy. He will redeem their life from oppression *and* fraud and violence, and their blood will be precious in His sight.

Ps 91:1 He who dwells in the shelter of the Most High will remain secure *and* rest in the shadow of the Almighty [whose power no enemy can withstand].

Ps 91:3 He will save you from the trap of the fowler, and from the deadly pestilence.

Ps 91:4 He will cover you *and* completely protect you with His pinions, and under His wings you will find refuge; His faithfulness is a shield and a wall.

Ps 91:5-7 You will not be afraid of the terror of night, nor of the arrow that flies by day, nor of the pestilence that stalks in darkness, nor of the destruction (sudden death) that lays waste at noon. A thousand may fall at your side and ten thousand at your right hand, but danger will not come near you.

Ps 91: 9-10 Because you have made the Lord, [who is] my refuge, even the Most High, your dwelling place, no evil will befall you, nor will any plague come near your tent.

Ps 91:11-13 For He will command His angels in regard to you, to protect *and* defend *and* guard you in all your ways. They will lift you up in their hands, so that you do not [even] strike your foot against a stone. You will tread upon the lion and cobra; the young lion and the serpent you will trample underfoot.

Ps 91:15-16 He will call upon Me, and I will answer him; I will be with him in trouble; I will rescue him and honor him. With a long life I will satisfy him and I will let him see My salvation.

Ps 118:17 I will not die, but live, and declare the works *and* recount the illustrious acts of the Lord.

Ps 121:3 He will not allow your foot to slip *or* to be moved; He Who keeps you will not slumber.

Ps 121:7-8 The Lord will protect you from all evil; He will keep your life. The Lord will guard your going out and your coming in [everything that you do] from this time forth and forever.

Prov 12:21 No [actual] evil, misfortune, *or* calamity shall come upon the righteous.

Mark 16:17-18 These signs will accompany those who have believed: in My name they will cast out demons, they will speak in new tongues; they will pick up serpents, and if they drink anything deadly, it will not hurt them.

Luke 10:19 Listen carefully: I have given you authority [that you now possess] to tread on serpents and scorpions, and [the ability to exercise authority] over all the power of the enemy (Satan); and nothing will [in any way] harm you.

Luke 21:18 Not a hair of your head will perish.

Rom 8:11 And if the Spirit of Him Who raised up Jesus from the dead dwells in you, [then] He Who raised up Christ *Jesus* from the dead will also restore to life your mortal (short-lived, perishable) bodies through His Spirit Who dwells in you.

II Cor 12:9 He said to me, My grace (My favor and loving-kindness and mercy) is enough for you [sufficient against any danger and enables you to bear the trouble manfully].

II Thes 3:3 The Lord is faithful, and He will strengthen you [setting you on a firm foundation] and will protect *and* guard you from the evil *one*.

I Pet 4:8 Above all, have fervent *and* unending love for one another, because love covers a multitude of sins [it overlooks unkindness and unselfishly seeks the best for others].

I John 4:17 As He is, so are we in this world.

WISDOM/UNDERSTANDING/MIND

Ps 49:3 My mouth will speak wisdom, and the meditation of my heart will be understanding.

Ps 119:125 I am Your servant; give me understanding (discernment and comprehension), that I may know (discern and be familiar with the character of) Your testimonies. Note, New Covenant = I am Your son/daughter, I have understanding...

Prov 3:5-6 Lean on, trust in, *and* be confident in the Lord with all your heart *and* mind and do not rely on your own insight *or* understanding. In all your ways know, recognize, *and* acknowledge Him, and He will direct *and* make straight *and* plain your paths.

Prov 3:32 For the devious are repulsive to the Lord; but His confidential communion *and* secret counsel are with the [uncompromisingly] righteous (those who are upright and in right standing with Him).

Prov 13: 20 He who walks [as a companion] with wise men will be wise.

Prov 16:3 Roll your works upon the Lord [commit and trust them wholly to Him; He will cause your thoughts to become agreeable to His will, and] so shall your plans be established *and* succeed.

Ecc 2:26 For to the person who pleases Him God gives wisdom, knowledge, and joy. Note, New Covenant = Jesus pleases Him, so you please Him.

Is 50:4-5 The Lord God has given Me [His Servant] the tongue of disciples [as One who is educated], that I may know how to sustain the weary with a word. He awakens *Me* morning by morning, He awakens My ear to listen as a disciple [as One who is taught]. The Lord God has opened My ear.

Luke 21:15 For I [Myself] will give you a mouth *and* such utterance and wisdom that all of your foes combined will be unable to stand against or refute.

John 14:26 The Helper (Comforter, Advocate, Intercessor—Counselor, Strengtheners, Standby), the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in My name [in My place, to represent Me and act on My behalf], He will teach you all things. And He will help you remember everything that I have told you.

I Cor 1:30 It is from Him that you have your life in Christ Jesus, Whom God made our Wisdom from God. Note, Jesus is our wisdom and He is in us.

I Cor 2:16 For who has known the mind *and* purposes of the Lord, so as to instruct Him? But we have the mind of Christ [to be guided by His thoughts, feelings and purposes].

Eph 1:7-8 In accordance with the riches *and* the generosity of His gracious favor, which He lavished upon us in every kind of wisdom and understanding (practical insight and prudence).

Eph 1:17 [I always pray] that the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may grant you a spirit of wisdom and of revelation [that gives you a deep and personal and intimate insight] into the true knowledge of Him. Note, confess “I have a spirit of wisdom and revelation...”

Phil 4:8 Whatever is true, whatever is honorable *and* worthy of respect, whatever is right *and* confirmed by God’s word, whatever is pure *and* wholesome, whatever is lovely *and* brings peace, whatever is admirable *and* of good repute; if there is any excellence, if there is anything worthy of praise, think *continually* on these things [center your mind on them, and implant them in your heart].

II Tim 1:7 For God did not give us a spirit of timidity *or* cowardice *or* fear, but [He has given us a spirit] of power and of love and of sound judgment *and* personal discipline [abilities that result in a calm, well-balanced mind and self-control].

I John 4:17 As He is, so are we in this world.

James 1:5 If any of you lacks wisdom [to guide him through a decision or circumstance], he is to ask of [our benevolent] God, who gives to everyone generously and without rebuke *or* blame, and it will be given to him.

HOMES/PROPERTY

Lev 26:6 I will grant peace in the land, so that you may lie down and there will be no one to make you afraid. I will also eliminate harmful animals from the land, and no sword will pass through your land.

Deut 6:10 And when the Lord your God brings you into the land which He swore to your fathers, to Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob, to give you, with great and goodly cities which you did not build, and houses full of all good things which you did not fill, and cisterns hewn out which you did not hew, and vineyards and olive trees which you did not plant.

Deut 8:7-10 For the Lord your God is bringing you into a good land, a land of brooks of water, of fountains and springs, flowing forth in valleys and hills; a land of wheat and barley, and vines and fig trees and pomegranates, a land of olive oil and honey; a land where you will eat bread without shortage, in which you will lack nothing; a land whose stones are iron, and out of whose hills you can dig copper. **10** When you have eaten and are satisfied, then you shall bless the Lord your God for the good land which He has given you.

Deut 28:8 He will bless you in the land which the Lord your God gives you.

Deut 28:11 The Lord will give you great prosperity, in the offspring of your body and in the offspring of your livestock and the produce of your ground.

Deut 28:12 The Lord will open for you His good treasure house, the heavens, to give rain to your land in its season and to bless all the work of your hand; and you will lend to many nations, but you will not borrow.

Josh 24:13 I gave you a land for which you did not labor, and cities which you did not build, and you live in them; you eat from vineyards and olive groves which you did not plant.

Job 5:24 You will know also that your tent is secure *and* at peace, and you will visit your dwelling and fear no loss [nor find anything amiss].

Ps 16:6 The [boundary] lines [of the land] have fallen for me in pleasant places; indeed, my heritage is beautiful to me.

Ps 25:13 He himself shall dwell at ease, and his offspring shall inherit the land.

Ps 37:34 He will exalt you to inherit the land.

Ps 44:3 For our fathers did not possess the land [of Canaan] by their own sword, nor did their own arm save them, but Your right hand and Your arm and the light of Your presence, because You favored *and* delighted in them.

Prov 3:33 He declares blessed (joyful and favored with blessings) the home of the just.

Prov 23:7 For as a man thinks in his heart, so is he. Thoughts have creative ability, so thinking about owning and living in your dream home debt-free should be a priority.

Prov 24:3-4 Through skillful *and* godly Wisdom is a house (a life, a home, a family) built, and by understanding it is established [on a sound and good foundation], and by knowledge shall its chambers [of every area] be filled with all precious and pleasant riches.

Is 58:12 And your people will rebuild the ancient ruins; you will raise up *and* restore the age-old foundations [of buildings that have been laid waste]; you will be called Repairer of the Breach, Restorer of Streets with Dwellings.

Matt 8:13 It will be done for you as you have believed.

Matt 9:29 Then He touched their eyes, saying, “According to your faith [your trust and confidence in My power and My ability to heal] it will be done to you.”

Mark 9:23 Jesus said to him, “[You say to Me,] ‘If You can?’ All things are possible for the one who believes *and* trusts [in Me]!”

Mark 10:27 Jesus said, “With people [as far as it depends on them] it is impossible, but not with God; for all things are possible with God.”

Mark 11:24 Whatever things you ask for in prayer [in accordance with God’s will], believe [with confident trust] that you have received them, and they will be *given* to you.

John 10:10 I came that they may have *and* enjoy life, and have it in abundance [to the full, till it overflows]. Note, God provides so we can have enjoyment, not so we merely don’t lack.

Rom 8:32 He who did not spare [even] His own Son, but gave Him up for us all, how will He not also, along with Him, graciously give us all things?

I Cor 2:5 So that your faith would not rest on the wisdom *and* rhetoric of men, but on the power of God.

II Cor 9:8 And God is able to make all grace (every favor and earthly blessing) come to you in abundance, so that you may always *and* under all circumstances *and* whatever the need be self-sufficient [possessing enough to require no aid or support and furnished in abundance for every good work and charitable donation].

Eph 3:20-21 Now to Him Who, by (in consequence of) the [action of His] power that is at work within us, is able to [carry out His purpose and] do superabundantly, far over *and* above all that we [dare] ask or think [infinitely beyond our highest prayers, desires, thoughts, hopes, or dreams] - to Him be glory in Christ Jesus throughout all generations forever and ever.

I John 4:17 As He is, so are we in this world.

AUTHORITY

Gen 1:26-30 God said, Let Us [Father, Son, and Holy Spirit] make mankind in Our image, after Our likeness, and let them have complete authority over the fish of the sea, the birds of the air, the [tame] beasts, and over all of the earth, and over everything that creeps upon the earth. And God blessed them and said to them, Be fruitful, multiply, and fill the earth, and subdue it [using all its vast resources in the service of God and man]; and have dominion over the fish of the sea, the birds of the air, and over every living creature that moves upon the earth. And God said, See, I have given you every plant yielding seed that is on the face of all the land and every tree with seed in its fruit; you shall have them for food. And to all the animals on the earth and to every bird of the air and to everything that creeps on the ground—to everything in which there is the breath of life—I have given every green plant for food. And it was so.

Job 22:28 You will also decide *and* decree a thing, and it will be established for you; and the light [of God's favor] will shine upon your ways.

Psalms 8:5-8 Yet You have made him a little lower than God, and You have crowned him with glory and honor. You made him to have dominion over the works of Your hands; you have put all things under his feet, all sheep and oxen, and also the beasts of the field, the birds of the air, and the fish of the sea, whatever passes through the paths of the seas. Note, translations that say man is made a little lower than the angels are translated incorrectly, original Hebrew says lower than God, period, future translators were scared to say we were only a little lower than a sovereign God, and they changed it to heavenly beings, and then that got changed to angels in later translations.

Ps 115:16 The heavens are the Lord's heavens, but the earth has He given to the children of men.

Ecc 8:4 For the word of a king is authority *and* power (Christ made us all kings and priests).

Matt 6:10 Your kingdom come, Your will be done on earth as it is in heaven. Note, in the original Greek Jesus made an imperative statement here, not a request, and the literal Greek translation is Kingdom of God, COME! Will of God COME! We need to Declare and DEMAND: Kingdom of God, come! Will of God, come! on earth as it is in heaven (in my body, in my finances, in battle situations as it is in heaven).

Matt 16:19 (Jesus speaking) I will give you the keys (authority) of the kingdom of heaven; and whatever you bind [forbid, declare to be improper and unlawful] on earth will have [already] been bound in heaven, and whatever you loose [permit, declare lawful] on earth will have

[already] been loosed in heaven. Note, the original Greek wording for already bound and already loosed translates must already be bound in heaven, must already be loosed in earth. Anything you are binding or loosing here must be in agreement with how the kingdom operates.

Mark 16:17-18 And these attesting signs will accompany those who believe: in My name they will drive out demons; they will speak in new languages; they will pick up serpents; and [even] if they drink anything deadly, it will not hurt them; they will lay their hands on the sick, and they will get well.

Luke 10:19 (Jesus speaking) Listen carefully! I have given you authority [that you now possess] to tread on serpents and scorpions, and [the ability to exercise authority] over all the power of the enemy (Satan); and nothing will [in any way] harm you. Nevertheless do not rejoice at this, that the spirits are subject to you, but rejoice that your names are recorded in heaven.

John 14:12 I assure you *and* most solemnly say to you, anyone who believes in Me [as Savior] will also do the things that I do; and he will do even greater things than these [in extent and outreach], because I am going to the Father.

Romans 5:17 Surely will those who receive [God's] overflowing grace (unmerited favor) and the free gift of righteousness [putting them into right standing with Himself] reign as kings in life through the one Man Jesus Christ (the Messiah, the Anointed One). Note, the word receive in the original Greek is a present active tense, meaning we must keep receiving grace, continually.

I Cor 7:4 The wife does not have [exclusive] authority over her own body, but the husband *shares with her*; and likewise the husband does not have [exclusive] authority over his body, but the wife *shares with him*.

Phil 2:10 At the name of Jesus every knee shall bow [in submission], of those who are in heaven and on earth and under the earth.

I John 4:17 As He is, so are we in this world.

Rev 1:6 To Him Who ever loves us and has once [for all] loosed *and* freed us from our sins by His own blood, and formed us into a kingdom (a royal race), priests to His God and Father - to Him be the glory and the power *and* the majesty and the dominion throughout the ages *and* forever and ever. Amen (so be it). Note, we are all kings (royalty) and priests.

MARRIAGE

Ps 128:3 Your wife shall be like a fruitful vine in the innermost parts of your house; your children shall be like olive plants round about your table.

Prov 3:33 He declares blessed (joyful and favored with blessings) the home of the just.

Prov 5:15 Drink waters out of your own cistern [of a pure marriage relationship], and fresh running waters out of your own well.

Prov 5:18-19 Let your fountain [of human life] be blessed [with the rewards of fidelity], and rejoice in the wife of your youth. Let her be as the loving hind and pleasant doe [tender, gentle, attractive] - let her bosom satisfy you at all times, and always be transported with delight in her love. Note, wives declare, Our lives are blessed with the rewards of fidelity and my husband rejoices in me, I am loving, pleasant, tender, gentle and attractive to my husband and my body satisfies him at all times, he is transported with delight by my love. Husbands declare, My wife IS loving, pleasant, tender, gentle, etc....

Prov 17:9 He who covers *and* forgives an offense seeks love, but he who repeats *or* harps on a matter separates even close friends.

Prov 18:22 He who finds a [true and faithful] wife finds a good thing and obtains favor *and* approval from the Lord.

Prov 23:7 For as a man thinks in his heart, so is he. Note, thoughts have creative ability, so thinking about your marriage being happy and excellent and your spouse being excellent should be a priority.

Prov 31:10-12 An excellent woman [one who is spiritual, capable, intelligent, and virtuous], who is he who can find her? Her value is more precious than jewels *and* her worth is far above rubies *or* pearls. The heart of her husband trusts in her confidently *and* relies on and believes in her securely, so that he has no lack of [honest] gain or need of [dishonest] spoil. She comforts, encourages, *and* does him only good and not evil all the days of her life.

Prov 31:17-18 An excellent woman equips herself with strength [spiritual, mental, and physical fitness for her God-given task] and makes her arms strong. She tastes and sees that her gain from work [with and for God] is good; her lamp goes not out, but it burns on continually through the night [of trouble, privation, or sorrow, warning away fear, doubt, and distrust].

Prov 31:21, 23 An excellent woman fears not the snow for her family, for all her household are double clothed in [expensive] scarlet [wool]. Her husband is known in the [city's] gates, when he sits among the elders of the land.

Prov 31:25-27 Strength and dignity are her clothing *and* her position is strong and secure; and she smiles at the future [knowing that she and her family are prepared]. She opens her mouth in [skillful and godly] wisdom, and the teaching of kindness is on her tongue [giving counsel and instruction]. She looks well to how things go in her household, and the bread of idleness (gossip, discontent, and self-pity) she will not eat.

Prov 31: 28-29 Her children rise up and call her blessed (happy, prosperous, to be admired); her husband also, and he praises her, *saying*, many daughters have done nobly, *and* well [with the strength of character that is steadfast in goodness], but you excel them all.

Is 54:17 No weapon that is formed against you will succeed. Note, if no weapon that is formed against you can succeed, then neither can any weapon formed against your marriage.

Mark 9:23 Jesus said to him, “[You say to Me,] ‘If You can?’ All things are possible for the one who believes *and* trusts [in Me]!”

Eph 4:1-3 So I, the prisoner for the Lord, appeal to you to live a life worthy of the calling to which you have been called [that is, to live a life that exhibits godly character, moral courage, personal integrity, and mature behavior - a life that expresses gratitude to God for your salvation], with all humility [forsaking self-righteousness], and gentleness [maintaining self-control], with patience, bearing with one another in [unselfish] love. Make every effort to keep the oneness of the Spirit in the bond of peace [each individual working together to make the whole successful].

Eph 4:29 Let no foul *or* polluting language, *nor* evil word *nor* unwholesome *or* worthless talk [ever] come out of your mouth, but only such [speech] as is good *and* beneficial to the spiritual progress of others, as is fitting to the need *and* the occasion, that it may be a blessing *and* give grace (God’s favor) to those who hear it. Note, speaking an encouraging word, a spiritually positive word to your spouse literally causes God to give divine favor to them.

Eph 5:25, 28-29 Husbands, love your wives [seek the highest good for her and surround her with a caring, unselfish love], just as Christ also loved the church and gave Himself up for her, Even so husbands should *and* are morally obligated to love their own wives as [being in a sense] their own bodies. He who loves his own wife loves himself. For no one ever hated his own body, but [instead] he nourishes *and* protects and cherishes it, just as Christ does the church.

Eph 5:33 Each man among you [without exception] is to love his wife as his very own self [with behavior worthy of respect and esteem, always seeking the best for her with an attitude of lovingkindness], and the wife [must see to it] that she respects *and* delights in her husband [that she notices him and prefers him and treats him with loving concern, treasuring him, honoring him, and holding him dear].

I Cor 7:4 The wife does not have [exclusive] authority over her own body, but the husband *shares with her*; and likewise the husband does not have [exclusive] authority over his body, but the wife *shares with him*.

I Tim 5:8 If anyone fails to provide for his relatives, and especially for those of his own family, he has disowned the faith [by failing to accompany it with fruits] and is worse than an unbeliever [who performs his obligation in these matters].

CHILDREN

Gen 27:28-29 (blessing Isaac spoke over Jacob) Now may God give you of the dew of heaven [to water your land], and of the fatness (fertility) of the earth, and an abundance of grain and new wine; may peoples serve you, and nations bow down to you; may those who curse you be cursed, and may those who bless you be blessed.”

Deut 11:19-21 You shall teach My words [diligently] to your children [impressing God’s precepts on their minds and penetrating their hearts with His truths], speaking of them when you sit in your house and when you walk along the road and when you lie down and when you rise up. You shall write them on the doorposts of your house and on your gates, so that your days and the days of your children may be multiplied in the land which the Lord swore to your fathers to give them, as long as the heavens are above the earth.

Deut 28:4 The offspring of your body and the produce of your ground and the offspring of your animals, the offspring of your herd and the young of your flock *will be* blessed.

Deut 28:41 (Note, this verse is part of the curse of the law, and Jesus has redeemed us from it, so declare you walk in the blessing and your child will never go into any form of captivity) You will have sons and daughters, but they will not be yours [for long], because they will go into captivity.

Josh 24:15 As for me and my house, we will serve the Lord.

Ps 112:2 His descendants (children) will be mighty on earth; the generation of the upright will be blessed.

Ps 115:14 May the Lord give you increase more and more, you and your children.

Ps 127:3-6 Behold, children are a heritage *and* gift from the Lord, the fruit of the womb a reward. Like arrows in the hand of a warrior, so are the children of one’s youth. How blessed [happy and fortunate] is the man whose quiver is filled with them; they will not be ashamed when they speak with their enemies [in gatherings] at the [city] gate.

Ps 128:3 Your wife shall be like a fruitful vine in the innermost parts of your house; your children shall be like olive plants round about your table. Note, at the time this was written, olive plants were recognized as beneficial, established and in a high place on the land.

Ps 128:6 Yes, may you see your children’s children.

Prov 17:6 Grandchildren are the crown of aged men, and the glory of children is their fathers [who live godly lives].

Prov 22:6 Train up a child in the way he should go [and in keeping with his individual gift or bent], and when he is old he will not depart from it.

Prov 22:15 Foolishness is bound up in the heart of a child; the rod of discipline [correction administered with godly wisdom and lovingkindness] will remove it far from him.

Prov 23:7 For as a man thinks in his heart, so is he. Thoughts have creative ability, so thinking about your child being healthy, happy, successful, spiritually mature, blessing the family and others, etc. should be a priority.

Prov 29:15, 17 The rod and reproof (godly instruction) give wisdom, but a child (left undisciplined) who gets his own way brings shame to his mother. Correct your son, and he will give you rest; yes, he will give delight to your heart.

Prov 31: 28 Her children rise up and call her blessed (happy, prosperous, to be admired).

Is 49:25 I will contend with your opponent, and I will save your children.

Is 54:13 All your [spiritual] children shall be disciples [taught by the Lord and obedient to His will], and great shall be the peace *and* undisturbed composure of your children.

Is 54:17 No weapon that is formed against you will succeed. Note, if no weapon that is formed against you can succeed, then neither can any weapon formed against your family.

Is 60:1-5 Arise [from the depression and prostration in which circumstances have kept you—rise to a new life]! Shine (be radiant with the glory of the Lord), for your light has come, and the glory of the Lord has risen upon you! nations shall come to your light, and kings to the brightness of your rising. Lift up your eyes round about you and see! They all gather themselves together, they come to you. Your sons shall come from afar, and your daughters shall be carried *and* nursed in the arms. Then you shall see and be radiant, and your heart shall thrill *and* tremble with joy [at the glorious deliverance] and be enlarged.

Jer 24:7 I will give them a heart to know (recognize, understand, and be acquainted with) Me, that I am the Lord; and they will be My people, and I will be their God, for they will return to Me with their whole heart.

Jer 31:16-17 Thus says the Lord: Restrain your voice from weeping and your eyes from tears, for your work shall be rewarded, says the Lord; and [your children] shall return from the enemy's land. And there is hope for your future, says the Lord; your children shall come back to their own country.

Joel 2:28 I shall pour out My Spirit on all mankind; and your sons and your daughters will prophesy. Your old men will dream dreams, your young men will see visions.

Mark 9:23 Jesus said to him, “[You say to Me,] ‘If You can?’ All things are possible for the one who believes *and* trusts [in Me]!”

John 10:4-5 The sheep follow him because they know his voice *and* recognize his call. **5** They will never follow a stranger, but will run away from him, because they do not know the voice of strangers. Note, decree this over your saved children, they will always follow the voice of God and never follow the voice of the world or the devil, but will flee from them.

Eph 4:29 Let no foul *or* polluting language, *nor* evil word *nor* unwholesome *or* worthless talk [ever] come out of your mouth, but only such [speech] as is good *and* beneficial to the spiritual progress of others, as is fitting to the need *and* the occasion, that it may be a blessing *and* give grace (God's favor) to those who hear it. Note, speaking an encouraging word, a spiritually positive word to child your literally causes God to give divine favor to them.

I Tim 5:8 If anyone fails to provide for his relatives, and especially for those of his own family, he has disowned the faith [by failing to accompany it with fruits] and is worse than an unbeliever [who performs his obligation in these matters].

EMOTIONS

Ps 13:5 But I have trusted, leaned on, *and* been confident in Your mercy *and* loving-kindness; my heart shall rejoice *and* be in high spirits in Your salvation.

Ps 16:11 You will show me the path of life; in Your presence is fullness of joy, at Your right hand there are pleasures forevermore.

Ps 21:6 You make him most blessed [and a blessing] forever; You make him joyful with the joy of Your presence.

Ps 34:5 They looked to Him and were radiant; their faces will never blush in shame *or* confusion.

Ps 34:8 O taste and see that the Lord [our God] is good! Blessed (happy, fortunate, to be envied) is the man who trusts *and* takes refuge in Him.

Ps 34:18 The Lord is close to those who are of a broken heart.

Ps 35:27 Let those who favor my righteous cause *and* have pleasure in my uprightness shout for joy and be glad and say continually, Let the Lord be magnified, Who takes pleasure in the prosperity of His servant.

Ps 39:13 That I may recover cheerfulness *and* encouraging strength *and* know gladness.

Ps 45:7 You love righteousness, uprightness, *and* right standing with God and hate wickedness; therefore God, Your God, has anointed You with the oil of gladness above your companions.

Ps 51:8 Make me to hear joy and gladness *and* be satisfied.

Ps 97:11 Light is sown [like seed] for the righteous *and* illuminates their path, and [irrepressible] joy [is spread] for the upright in heart [who delight in His favor and protection].

Ps 119:165 Nothing shall offend them *or* make them stumble.

Prov 12:16 A fool's wrath is quickly and openly known, but a prudent man ignores an insult.

Prov 16:32 He who is slow to anger is better *and* more honorable than the mighty [soldier], and he who rules *and* controls his own spirit, than he who captures a city.

Prov 23:7 For as a man thinks in his heart, so is he. Thoughts have creative ability, so thinking of yourself happy, laughing, joyful, in high spirits, emotionally stable, mentally fit and whole in every way should be a priority.

Ecc 5:19-20 Every man to whom God has given riches and possessions, He has also given the power *and* ability to enjoy them and to receive [this as] his [allotted] portion and to rejoice in his labor - this is the gift of God [to him]. For he will not often consider the [troubled] days of his life, because God keeps him occupied *and* focused on the joy of his heart [and the tranquility of God indwells him].

Is 51:11-12 [The Lord God says] And the redeemed of the Lord shall return and come with singing to Zion; everlasting joy shall be upon their heads. They shall obtain joy and gladness, and sorrow and sighing shall flee away. I, even I, am He Who comforts you.

Is 54:4 Do not fear, for you will not be put to shame, and do not feel humiliated *or* ashamed, for you will not be disgraced. For you will forget the shame of your youth, and you will no longer remember the disgrace of your widowhood.

Is 60:1 Arise [from the depression and prostration in which circumstances have kept you—rise to a new life]! Shine (be radiant with the glory of the Lord), for your light has come, and the glory of the Lord has risen upon you!

Is 61:1-3 (prophesy about Jesus) The Spirit of the Lord God is upon me, because the Lord has anointed *and* qualified me to preach the Gospel *of* good tidings to the meek, the poor, *and* afflicted; He has sent me to bind up *and* heal the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to the [physical and spiritual] captives and the opening of the prison *and* of the eyes to those who are bound, to proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord [the year of His favor] and the day of vengeance of our God, to comfort all who mourn, to grant [consolation and joy] to those who mourn in Zion - to give them an ornament (a garland or diadem) of beauty instead of ashes, the oil of joy instead of mourning, the garment [expressive] of praise instead of a heavy, burdened, *and* failing spirit - that they may be called oaks of righteousness [lofty, strong, and magnificent, distinguished for uprightness, justice, and right standing with God], the planting of the Lord, that He may be glorified.

Jer 31:12-13 They will come and sing aloud *and* shout for joy on the height of Zion, and will be radiant [with joy] over the goodness of the Lord - for the grain, for the new wine, for the oil, and for the young of the flock and the herd. And their life will be like a watered garden, and they shall never sorrow *or* languish again. For I will turn their mourning into joy and will comfort them and make them rejoice after their sorrow.

Jer 31:25 For I [fully] satisfy the weary soul, and I replenish every languishing *and* sorrowful person.

John 15:11 I have told you these things so that My joy *and* delight may be in you, and that your joy may be made full *and* complete *and* overflowing.

John 16:33 I have told you these things, so that in Me you may have [perfect] peace. In the world you have tribulation *and* distress *and* suffering, but be courageous [be confident, be undaunted, be filled with joy]; I have overcome the world.” [My conquest is accomplished, My victory abiding.]

John 17: 13 (Jesus speaking) So that they may experience My joy made full *and* complete *and* perfect within them [filling their hearts with My delight].

Rom 15:13 May the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace in believing [through the experience of your faith] that by the power of the Holy Spirit you will abound in hope *and* overflow with confidence in His promises.

II Cor 7:6 But God, Who comforts *and* encourages *and* refreshes *and* cheers the depressed *and* the sinking, comforted *and* encouraged *and* refreshed *and* cheered us.

Ephesians 4:26-27 When angry, do not sin; do not ever let your wrath (your exasperation, your fury or indignation) last until the sun goes down. Leave no [such] room *or* foothold for the devil [give no opportunity to him].

Ephesians 6:10 Be strong in the Lord (be empowered through your union with Him); draw your strength from Him (that strength which His boundless might provides).

Heb 13:5-6 He [God] Himself has said, I will not in any way fail you *nor* give you up *nor* leave you without support. [I will] not, [I will] not, [I will] not in any degree leave you helpless *nor* forsake *nor* let [you] down (relax My hold on you)! [Assuredly not!]. Note, people verifying against the original Greek manuscripts have said how this strong and emphatic wording and repeating “I will not” three times, etc. is all there, that God really wanted His assurances believed and never doubted.

James 1:19-20 Understand this, my beloved brothers and sisters. Let everyone be quick to hear [be a careful, thoughtful listener], slow to speak [a speaker of carefully chosen words and], slow to anger [patient, reflective, forgiving]; for the [resentful, deep-seated] anger of man does not produce the righteousness of God [that standard of behavior which He requires from us].

STRENGTH

Deut 33:25 As your days are (note, your age), so will your strength, your rest *and* security be.

Josh 14:10-11 (Caleb speaking) I am this day eighty-five years old. Yet I am as strong today as I was the day Moses sent me (Note, sent at age 40); as my strength was then, so is my strength now for war and to go out and to come in.

I Sam 30:6 David was greatly distressed, for the men spoke of stoning him because the souls of them all were bitterly grieved. But David encouraged *and* strengthened himself in the Lord his God.

II Chron 15:7 Be strong, therefore, and let not your hands be weak *and* slack, for your work shall be rewarded.

Job 4:4 Your words have helped the one who was stumbling to stand, and you have strengthened feeble knees.

Ps 18:31-32 For who is God except the Lord? Or who is the Rock save our God, the God who girds me with strength and makes my way perfect.

Ps 28:7-8 The Lord is my strength and my [impenetrable] shield; my heart trusts [with unwavering confidence] in Him, and I am helped; therefore my heart greatly rejoices, and with my song I shall thank Him *and* praise Him. The Lord is their [unyielding] strength, and He is the fortress of salvation to His anointed.

Ps 29:11 The Lord will give [unyielding and impenetrable] strength to His people; the Lord will bless His people with peace.

Ps. 84:5,7 Blessed *and* greatly favored is the man whose strength is in You...They go from strength to strength [increasing in victorious power].

Prov 23:7 For as a man thinks in his heart, so is he. Thoughts have creative ability, so thinking about yourself as physically, spiritually, emotionally and mentally strong should be a priority.

Is 40:28-31 The everlasting God, the Lord, the Creator of the ends of the earth, does not faint or grow weary; there is no searching of His understanding. He gives power to the faint *and* weary, and to him who has no might He increases strength [causing it to multiply and making it to abound]. Even youths shall faint and be weary, and young men shall feebly stumble *and* fall exhausted; but those who wait for the Lord [who expect, look for, and hope in Him] shall change *and* renew their strength *and* power; they shall lift their wings *and* mount up [close to God] as eagles [mount up to the sun]; they shall run and not be weary, they shall walk and not faint *or* become tired.

Is 41:10 Fear not [there is nothing to fear], for I am with you; do not look around you in terror *and* be dismayed, for I am your God. I will strengthen *and* harden you to difficulties, yes, I will help you; yes, I will hold you up *and* retain you with My [victorious] right hand of rightness *and* justice.

Is 58:11 And the Lord shall guide you continually and satisfy you in drought *and* in dry places and make strong your bones. And you shall be like a watered garden and like a spring of water whose waters fail not.

Jer 31:25 For I [fully] satisfy the weary soul, and I replenish every languishing *and* sorrowful person.

Joel 3:10 Let the weak say, “I am strong!”

II Cor 12:9-10 But He said to me, My grace (My favor and loving-kindness and mercy) is enough for you [sufficient against any danger and enables you to bear the trouble manfully]; for *My* strength *and* power are made perfect (fulfilled and completed) *and show themselves most effective* in [your] weakness. Therefore, I will all the more gladly glory in my weaknesses *and* infirmities, that the strength *and* power of Christ (the Messiah) may rest (yes, may pitch a tent over and dwell) upon me! So for the sake of Christ, I am well pleased *and* take pleasure in infirmities, insults, hardships, persecutions, perplexities *and* distresses; for when I am weak in human strength], then am I [truly] strong (able, powerful in divine strength).

Eph 6:10 Be strong in the Lord [draw your strength from Him and be empowered through your union with Him] and in the power of His [boundless] might.

Phil 4:13 I can do all things [which He has called me to do] through Him who strengthens *and* empowers me [to fulfill His purpose—I am self-sufficient in Christ’s sufficiency; I am ready for anything and equal to anything through Him who infuses me with inner strength and confident peace.]

Col 1:11-12 [We pray that you may be] strengthened *and* invigorated with all power, according to His glorious might, to attain every kind of endurance and patience with joy; giving thanks to the Father.

Col 1:29 For this I labor [often to the point of exhaustion], striving with all the superhuman power *and* energy, which He so greatly works within me.

I Pet 4:11 Whoever serves [the congregation] *is to do so* as one who serves by the strength which God [abundantly] supplies, so that in all things God may be glorified [honored and magnified] through Jesus Christ.

RESTORATION

Is 51:3 For the Lord will comfort Zion [in her captivity]; He will comfort all her ruins. And He will make her wilderness like Eden, and her desert like the garden of the Lord; joy and gladness will be found in her, thanksgiving and the voice of a melody.

Is 61:6-8 You shall eat the wealth of the nations, and the glory [once that of your captors] shall be yours. Instead of your [former] shame you shall have a twofold recompense; instead of dishonor *and* reproach [your people] shall rejoice in their portion. Therefore in their land they shall possess double [what they had forfeited]; everlasting joy shall be theirs. For I the Lord love justice; I hate robbery *and* wrong.

Zech 9:12 Return to the stronghold [of security and prosperity], you prisoners of hope; even today do I declare that I will restore double your former prosperity to you.

Joel 2:25-26 I will compensate you for the years that the swarming locust has eaten. You will have plenty to eat and be satisfied and praise the name of the Lord your God Who has dealt wondrously with you; and My people shall never be put to shame. Note, insert whatever has been stolen from you for “the years the locust has eaten” eg, health, wealth, joy, relationships

Mark 10:29-30 Jesus said, I assure you *and* most solemnly say to you, there is no one who has given up a house or brothers or sisters or mother or father or children or farms, for My sake and for the gospel’s sake, who will not receive a hundred times as much now in the present age.

Rev 21:5 I make all things new.

HOLY SPIRIT

Ezek 36:26-27 I will give you a new heart and put a new spirit within you, and I will remove the heart of stone from your flesh and give you a heart of flesh. I will put my Spirit within you and cause you to walk in My statutes, and you will keep My ordinances and do them.

Luke 4:18-19 The Spirit of the Lord [is] upon Me, because He has anointed Me [the Anointed One, the Messiah] to preach the good news (the Gospel) to the poor; He has sent Me to announce release to the captives and recovery of sight to the blind, to send forth as delivered those who are oppressed [who are downtrodden, bruised, crushed, and broken down by calamity], to proclaim the accepted *and* acceptable year of the Lord [the day when salvation and the free favors of God profusely abound].

John 6:63 (Jesus speaking) It is the Spirit who gives life; the flesh conveys no benefit [it is of no account]. The words I have spoken to you are spirit and life [providing eternal life].

John 14:16-17 And I will ask the Father, and He will give you another Helper (Comforter, Advocate, Intercessor - Counselor, Strengtheners, Standby), to be with you forever - the Spirit of Truth, whom the world cannot receive [and take to its heart] because it does not see Him or know Him, *but* you know Him because He (the Holy Spirit) remains with you *continually* and will be in you.

John 14:26 But the Comforter (Counselor, Helper, Intercessor, Advocate, Strengtheners, Standby), the Holy Spirit, Whom the Father will send in My name [in My place, to represent Me and act on My behalf], He will teach you all things. And He will cause you to recall (will remind you of, bring to your remembrance) everything I have told you.

John 16:7 (Jesus speaking) However, I am telling you nothing but the truth when I say it is profitable (good, expedient, advantageous) for you that I go away. Because if I do not go away, the Comforter (Counselor, Helper, Advocate, Intercessor, Strengtheners, Standby) will not come to you [into close fellowship with you]; but if I go away, I will send Him to you [to be in close fellowship with you].

John 16:13-15 But when He, the Spirit of Truth, comes, He will guide you into all the truth [full and complete truth]. For He will not speak on His own initiative, but He will speak whatever He hears [from the Father—the message regarding the Son], and He will disclose to you what is to come [in the future]. He will glorify *and* honor Me, because He (the Holy Spirit) will take from what is Mine and will disclose it to you. All things that the Father has are Mine. Because of this I said that He [the Spirit] will take from what is Mine and will reveal it to you.

Rom 5:5 Such hope [in God's promises] never disappoints *or* deludes *or* shames us, for God's love has been poured out in our hearts through the Holy Spirit Who has been given to us.

Rom 7:6 But now we are discharged from the Law *and* have terminated all intercourse with it, having died to what once restrained *and* held us captive. So now we serve not under [obedience to] the old code of written regulations, but [under obedience to the promptings] of the Spirit in newness [of life].

Rom 8:2-5 For the law of the Spirit of life [which is] in Christ Jesus [the law of our new being] has set you free from the law of sin and of death. For what the Law could not do [that is, overcome sin and remove its penalty, its power] being weakened by the flesh [man's nature without the Holy Spirit], God did: He sent His own Son in the likeness of sinful man as an offering for sin. And He condemned sin in the flesh [subdued it and overcame it in the person of His own Son], so that the [righteous and just] requirement of the Law might be fulfilled in us who do not live our lives in the ways of the flesh [guided by worldliness and our sinful nature], but [live our lives] in the ways of the Spirit [guided by His power]. For those who are *living* according to the flesh set their minds on the things of the flesh [which gratify the body], but those who are *living* according to the Spirit, [set their minds on] the things of the Spirit [His will and purpose].

Rom 8:6-9 Now the mind of the flesh [which is sense and reason without the Holy Spirit] is death [death that comprises all the miseries arising from sin, both here and hereafter]. But the mind of the [Holy] Spirit is life and [soul] peace [both now and forever]. [That is] because the mind of the flesh [with its carnal thoughts and purposes] is hostile to God, for it does not submit itself to God's Law; indeed it cannot. So then those who are living the life of the flesh [catering to the appetites and impulses of their carnal nature] cannot please *or* satisfy God, *or* be acceptable to Him. But you are not living the life of the flesh, you are living the life of the Spirit, if the [Holy] Spirit of God [really] dwells within you [directs and controls you]. But if anyone does not possess the [Holy] Spirit of Christ, he is none of His [he does not belong to Christ, is not truly a child of God].

Rom 8:10-11 But if Christ lives in you, [then although] your [natural] body is dead by reason of sin *and* guilt, the spirit is alive because of [the] righteousness [that He imputes to you]. And if the Spirit of Him Who raised up Jesus from the dead dwells in you, [then] He Who raised up Christ *Jesus* from the dead will also restore to life your mortal (short-lived, perishable) bodies through His Spirit Who dwells in you.

Rom 8:14 For all who are *allowing themselves to* be led by the Spirit of God are sons of God.

Rom 8:26-28 The Spirit [comes to us and] helps us in our weakness. We do not know what prayer to offer *or* how to offer it as we should, but the Spirit Himself [knows our need and at the right time] intercedes on our behalf with sighs *and* groanings too deep for words. And He who searches the hearts knows what the mind of the Spirit is, because the Spirit intercedes [before God] on behalf of God's people in accordance with God's will. We are assured *and* know that God being a partner in their labor] all things work together *and* are [fitting into a plan] for good to *and* for those who love God and are called according to [His] design *and* purpose.

Rom 14:17-19 The kingdom of God is not *a matter of* eating and drinking, but of righteousness and peace and joy in the Holy Spirit. For the one who serves Christ in this way [recognizing that food choice is secondary] is acceptable to God and is approved by men. So then, let us pursue [with enthusiasm] the things which make for peace and the building up of one another [things which lead to spiritual growth].

Rom 15:13 May the God of your hope so fill you with all joy and peace in believing [through the experience of your faith] that by the power of the Holy Spirit you may abound *and* be overflowing (bubbling over) with confidence in His promises.

I Cor 2:9-13 as the Scripture says, What eye has not seen and ear has not heard and has not entered into the heart of man, [all that] God has prepared (made and keeps ready) for those who love Him [who hold Him in affectionate reverence, promptly obeying Him and gratefully recognizing the benefits He has bestowed]. Yet to us God has unveiled *and* revealed them by *and* through His Spirit, for the [Holy] Spirit searches diligently, exploring *and* examining everything, even sounding the profound and bottomless things of God [the divine counsels and things hidden and beyond man's scrutiny]. For what person perceives (knows and understands) what passes through a man's thoughts except the man's own spirit within him? Just so no one discerns (comes to know and comprehend) the thoughts of God except the Spirit of God. Now we have not received the spirit [that belongs to] the world, but the [Holy] Spirit Who is from God, [given to us] that we might realize *and* comprehend *and* appreciate the gifts [of divine favor and blessing so freely and lavishly] bestowed on us by God. And we are setting these truths forth in words not taught by human wisdom but taught by the [Holy] Spirit, combining *and* interpreting spiritual truths with spiritual language [to those who possess the Holy Spirit].

I Cor 6:17 The person who is united to the Lord becomes one spirit with Him. Note, my spirit and God's spirit are one.

I Cor 12:7-11 To each one is given the manifestation of the [Holy] Spirit [the evidence, the spiritual illumination of the Spirit] for good *and* profit. To one is given in *and* through the [Holy] Spirit [the power to speak] a message of wisdom, and to another [the power to express] a word of knowledge *and* understanding according to the same [Holy] Spirit; to another [wonder-working] faith by the same [Holy] Spirit, to another the extraordinary powers of healing by the one Spirit; to another the working of miracles, to another prophetic insight (the gift of interpreting the divine will and purpose); to another the ability to discern *and* distinguish between [the utterances of true] spirits [and false ones], to another various kinds of [unknown] tongues, to another the ability to interpret [such] tongues. All these [gifts, achievements, abilities] are inspired *and* brought to pass by one and the same [Holy] Spirit, Who apportions to each person individually [exactly] as He chooses.

II Cor 3:7-9 Now if the ministry of death, engraved in letters on stones [the covenant of the Law which led to death because of sin], came with such glory *and* splendor that the Israelites were not able to look steadily at the face of Moses because of its glory, [a brilliance] that was fading, how will the ministry of the Spirit [the new covenant which allows us to be Spirit-filled] fail to be even more glorious *and* splendid? For if the ministry that brings condemnation [the old covenant, the Law] has glory, how much more does glory overflow in the ministry that brings

righteousness [the new covenant which declares believers free of guilt and sets them apart for God's special purpose]!

II Cor 3:18 Now the Lord is the Spirit, and where the Spirit of the Lord is, *there* is liberty [emancipation from bondage, true freedom]. And we all, with unveiled face, *continually* seeing as in a mirror the glory of the Lord, are *progressively* being transformed into His image from [one degree of] glory to [even more] glory, which comes from the Lord, [who is] the Spirit.

Gal 3:13-14 Christ purchased our freedom [redeeming us] from the curse (doom) of the Law [and its condemnation] by [Himself] becoming a curse for us; to the end that through [their receiving] Christ Jesus, the blessing [promised] to Abraham might come upon the Gentiles, so that we through faith might [all] receive [the realization of] the promise of the [Holy] Spirit.

Gal 4:6 And because you [really] are [His] sons, God has sent the [Holy] Spirit of His Son into our hearts, crying, Abba (Daddy)! Father! Note, the Spirit cries out to the Father for us.

Gal 5:16-18 Walk *and* live [habitually] in the [Holy] Spirit [responsive to *and* controlled *and* guided by the Spirit]; then you will certainly not gratify the cravings *and* desires of the flesh (of human nature without God). For the desires of the flesh are opposed to the [Holy] Spirit, and the [desires of the] Spirit are opposed to the flesh (godless human nature); for these are antagonistic to each other [continually withstanding and in conflict with each other], so that you are not free *but* are prevented from doing what you desire to do. But if you are guided (led) by the [Holy] Spirit, you are not subject to the Law.

Gal 5:22-23 The fruit of the Spirit [the result of His presence within us] is love [unselfish concern for others], joy, [inner] peace, patience [not the ability to wait, but how we act while waiting], kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, self-control. Against such things there is no law.

Gal 5:25-26 If we live by the [Holy] Spirit, let us also walk by the Spirit. [If by the Holy Spirit we have our life in God, let us go forward walking in line, our conduct controlled by the Spirit.] Let us not become vainglorious *and* self-conceited, competitive *and* challenging *and* provoking *and* irritating to one another, envying *and* being jealous of one another.

Eph 1:3 May blessing (praise, laudation, and eulogy) be to the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ (the Messiah) Who has blessed us *in Christ* with every spiritual (given by the Holy Spirit) blessing in the heavenly realm!

Eph 3:16 May He grant you out of the rich treasury of His glory to be strengthened *and* reinforced with mighty power in the inner man by the [Holy] Spirit [Himself indwelling your innermost being and personality]. Note, pray this for your friends and family.

Hebrews 10:29 How much greater punishment do you think he will deserve who has rejected *and* trampled under foot the Son of God, and has considered unclean *and* common the blood of

the covenant that sanctified him, and has insulted the [Holy] Spirit of grace [who imparts the unmerited favor and blessing of God]?

Jude 20-21 Beloved, build yourselves up [founded] on your most holy faith [make progress, rise like an edifice higher and higher], praying in the Holy Spirit; guard *and* keep yourselves in the love of God; expect *and* patiently wait for the mercy of our Lord Jesus Christ (the Messiah) - [which will bring you] unto life eternal. Note, praying in the Holy Spirit builds you up.

ANGELS

Gen 24:39-40 (Abraham sending servant to find a wife for Isaac) Then I said to my master, but suppose the woman will not follow me [back to this land].’ He said to me, ‘The Lord, before whom I walk will send His angel with you to make your journey successful, and you will take a

wife for my son from my relatives and from my father's house. Abraham clearly believed in the ministry of angels, we have this same assistance today.

Ex 23:20 Behold, I send an Angel before you to keep *and* guard you on the way and to bring you to the place I have prepared.

Neh 9:6 You are the Lord, You alone; You have made the heavens, the heaven of heavens with all their host (the heavenly bodies), the earth and everything that is on it, the seas and everything that is in them. You give life to all of them, and the heavenly host is bowing down [in worship] to You.

Ps 34:7 The angel of the Lord encamps around those who fear Him [with awe-inspired reverence and worship Him], and He rescues [each of] them.

Ps 91:11-12 For He will command His angels in regard to you, to protect *and* defend *and* guard you in all your ways. They will lift you up in their hands, so that you do not [even] strike your foot against a stone.

Ps 103:20 Bless (affectionately, gratefully praise) the Lord, you His angels, you mighty ones who do His commandments, obeying the voice of His word. Note, when we quote God's words, angels go to work.

Matt 18:10 (Jesus speaking) Beware that you do not despise *or* feel scornful toward *or* think little of one of these little ones, for I tell you that in heaven their angels always are in the presence of *and* look upon the face of My Father Who is in heaven.

Heb 1:7 And concerning the angels He says, "Who makes His angels winds, and His ministering servants flames of fire [to do His bidding]."

Heb 1:14 Are not all the angels ministering spirits sent out [by God] to serve (accompany, protect) those who will inherit salvation? [Of course they are!]

REDEEMED FROM THE CURSE

Gal 3:13 Christ purchased our freedom *and* redeemed us from the curse of the Law *and* its condemnation by becoming a curse for us. Note, definition of redeemed is free from what distresses or harms; such as to free from captivity by payment of ransom. Refuse to accept or

yield to any form of the curse. It is your legal right to have none of the following in your life, so rebuke and renounce and curse these things and demand, receive and take by force the blessings:

Deut 28: 15-44, 48, 59-67

15 But if you will not obey the voice of the Lord your God, being watchful to do all His commandments and His statutes which I command you this day, then all these curses shall come upon you and overtake you:

16 Cursed shall you be in the city and cursed shall you be in the field.

17 Cursed shall be your basket and your kneading trough.

18 Cursed shall be the fruit of your body, of your land, of the increase of your cattle and the young of your sheep.

19 Cursed shall you be when you come in and cursed shall you be when you go out.

20 The Lord shall send you curses, confusion, and rebuke in every enterprise to which you set your hand, until you are destroyed, perishing quickly because of the evil of your doings by which you have forsaken me.

21 The Lord will make the pestilence cling to you until He has consumed you from the land into which you go to possess.

22 The Lord will smite you with consumption, with fever and inflammation, fiery heat, sword *and* drought, blight and mildew; they shall pursue you until you perish. Note, Andrew Wommack had a closet in his home that was on an uninsulated outer wall of the home, and because of the temperature difference between outdoors and in, there would constantly be condensation on this wall, and the closet was full of mold every season of the year. Finally, he remembered that mildew and mold were part of the curse of the law and he is redeemed from them, they cannot come upon him, so he stood in front of the closet, read this verse, rebuked the mold and mildew and commanded them to leave and for the walls of his home to be a blessing to him, and within a week it was all cleared up and never came back.

- 23** The heavens over your head shall be brass and the earth under you shall be iron.
- 24** The Lord shall make the rain of your land powdered soil and dust; from the heavens it shall come down upon you until you are destroyed.
- 25** The Lord shall cause you to be struck down before your enemies; you shall go out one way against them and flee seven ways before them, and you shall be tossed to and fro *and* be a terror among all the kingdoms of the earth.
- 26** And your dead body shall be food for all the birds of the air and the beasts of the earth, and there shall be no one to frighten them away.
- 27** The Lord will smite you with the boils of Egypt and the tumors, the scurvy and the itch, from which you cannot be healed.
- 28** The Lord will smite you with madness and blindness and dismay of [mind and] heart.
- 29** And you shall grope at noonday as the blind grope in darkness. And you shall not prosper in your ways; and you shall be only oppressed and robbed continually, and there shall be no one to save you.
- 30** You shall betroth a wife, but another man shall lie with her; you shall build a house, but not live in it; you shall plant a vineyard, but not gather its grapes.
- 31** Your ox shall be slain before your eyes, but you shall not eat of it; your donkey shall be violently taken away before your face and not be restored to you; your sheep shall be given to your enemies, and you shall have no one to help you.
- 32** Your sons and daughters shall be given to another people, and your eyes shall look and fail with longing for them all the day; and there shall be no power in your hands to prevent it.
- 33** A nation which you have not known shall eat up the fruit of your land and of all your labors, and you shall be only oppressed and crushed continually,
- 34** So that you shall be driven mad by the sights which your eyes shall see.

35 The Lord will smite you on the knees and on the legs with a sore boil that cannot be healed, from the sole of your foot to the top of your head.

36 The Lord shall bring you and your king whom you have set over you to a nation which neither you nor your fathers have known, and there you shall [be forced to] serve other gods, of wood and stone.

37 And you shall become an amazement, a proverb, and a byword among all the peoples to which the Lord will lead you.

38 You shall carry much seed out into the field and shall gather little in, for the locust shall consume it.

39 You shall plant vineyards and dress them but shall neither drink of the wine nor gather the grapes, for the worm shall eat them.

40 You shall have olive trees throughout all your territory but you shall not anoint yourselves with the oil, for your olive trees shall drop their fruit.

41 You shall beget sons and daughters but shall not enjoy them, for they shall go into captivity.

42 All your trees and the fruit of your ground shall the locust possess.

43 The transient (stranger) among you shall mount up higher and higher above you, and you shall come down lower and lower.

44 He shall lend to you, but you shall not lend to him; he shall be the head, and you shall be the tail.

48 Therefore you shall serve your enemies whom the Lord shall send against you, in hunger and thirst, in nakedness and in want of all things; and He will put a yoke of iron upon your neck until He has destroyed you.

59 Then the Lord will bring upon you and your descendants extraordinary strokes and blows, great plagues of long continuance, and grievous sicknesses of long duration.

60 Moreover, He will bring upon you all the diseases of Egypt of which you were afraid, and they shall cling to you.

61 Also every sickness and every affliction which is not written in this Book of the Law the Lord will bring upon you until you are destroyed.

65 And among these nations you shall find no ease and there shall be no rest for the sole of your foot; but the Lord will give you there a trembling heart, failing of eyes [from disappointment of hope], fainting of mind, *and* languishing of spirit.

66 Your life shall hang in doubt before you; day and night you shall be worried, and have no assurance of your life.

67 In the morning you shall say, Would that it were evening! and at evening you shall say, Would that it were morning! - because of the anxiety *and* dread of your [minds and] hearts and the sights which you shall see with your [own] eyes.

REDEEMED FROM THE CURSE INTO THE BLESSING

Know what a blessed life looks like and refuse anything else, command blessings to chase you down and overtake you!

Gal 3:14 Through [their receiving] Christ Jesus, the blessing [promised] to Abraham might come upon the Gentiles. Gen 22:17-18 (God speaking to Abraham) Indeed I will greatly bless you, and I will greatly multiply your descendants like the stars of the heavens and like the sand on the seashore; and your seed shall possess the gate of their enemies [as conquerors]. Through your seed all the nations of the earth shall be blessed, because you have heard *and* obeyed My voice. Gen 24:1 and the Lord had blessed Abraham in all things. Note, that is the blessing of Abraham, blessed in ALL things, period, and that is every Christian's blessing too.

The blessings of obedience listed in Deuteronomy 28 belong to every Christian as well because Christ was obedient, and he became our righteousness, we are in right standing with God and thus eligible for every blessing of obedience. Rom 5:19 For just as through one man's disobedience [his failure to hear, his carelessness] the many were made sinners, so through the obedience of the one Man the many will be made righteous *and* acceptable to God *and* brought into right standing with Him.

2 Cor 5:21 He made Christ who knew no sin to [judicially] be sin on our behalf, so that in Him we would become the righteousness of God [that is, we would be made acceptable to Him and placed in a right relationship with Him by His gracious lovingkindness].

Deut 28: 2-13

2 And all these blessings shall come upon you and overtake you if you heed the voice of the Lord your God.

3 Blessed shall you be in the city and blessed shall you be in the field.

4 Blessed shall be the fruit of your body and the fruit of your ground and the fruit of your beasts, the increase of your cattle and the young of your flock.

5 Blessed shall be your basket and your kneading trough.

6 Blessed shall you be when you come in and blessed shall you be when you go out.

7 The Lord shall cause your enemies who rise up against you to be defeated before your face; they shall come out against you one way and flee before you seven ways.

8 The Lord shall command the blessing upon you in your storehouse and in all that you undertake. And He will bless you in the land which the Lord your God gives you.

10 And all people of the earth shall see that you are called by the name [and in the presence of] the Lord, and they shall be afraid of you.

11 And the Lord shall make you have a surplus of prosperity, through the fruit of your body, of your livestock, and of your ground, in the land which the Lord swore to your fathers to give you.

12 The Lord shall open to you His good treasury, the heavens, to give the rain of your land in its season and to bless all the work of your hands; and you shall lend to many nations, but you shall not borrow.

13 And the Lord shall make you the head, and not the tail; and you shall be above only, and you shall not be beneath.

MISCELLANEOUS

Ps 68:19 Blessed be the Lord, Who bears our burdens *and* carries us day by day, even the God Who is our salvation!

Ps 115:3 But our God is in heaven; He does whatever He pleases.

Ps 141:3 Set a guard, O Lord, over my mouth; keep watch over the door of my lips [to keep me from speaking thoughtlessly].

Prov 22:29 Do you see a man diligent *and* skillful in his work? He will stand before kings; he will not stand before obscure men.

Prov 28:1 The wicked flee when no one pursues them, but the righteous are as bold as a lion.

Ecc 3:11 He has made everything beautiful *and* appropriate in its time.

Ecc 3:12-13 Know that there is nothing better for them than to be glad and to get *and* do good as long as they live; and also that every man should eat and drink and enjoy the good of all his labor - it is the gift of God.

Is 55:11 So shall My word be that goes forth out of My mouth: it shall not return to Me void [without producing any effect, useless], but it shall accomplish that which I please *and* purpose, and it shall prosper in the thing for which I sent it. Note, this is why we confess God's word back to Him and to our circumstances, these words can't be useless and of no effect, they must be effective.

Is 61:10 I will rejoice greatly in the Lord, my soul will exult in my God; for He has clothed me with garments of salvation, He has covered me with a robe of righteousness.

Jer 1:12 Then the Lord said to me, "You have seen well, for I am [actively] watching over My word to fulfill it."

Jer 31:31-34 (Our New Covenant) Behold, the days are coming, says the Lord, when I will make a new covenant with the house of Israel (the Northern Kingdom) and with the house of Judah (the Southern Kingdom), not like the covenant which I made with their fathers in the day when I took them by the hand to bring them out of the land of Egypt, My covenant which they broke, although I was a husband to them, says the Lord. But this is the covenant which I will make with the house of Israel after those days," says the Lord, I will put My law within them, and I will write it on their hearts; and I will be their God, and they will be My people. And each man will no longer teach his neighbor and his brother, saying, 'Know the Lord,' for they will all know Me [through personal experience], from the least of them to the greatest," says the Lord. For I will forgive their wickedness, and I will no longer remember their sin. Note, this means no more laws, rather, the Holy Spirit is in us to tell us good from evil for us, as what is good for one Christian can be evil for another; Ezekiel 36:27 says And I will put my Spirit within you, and cause you to walk in My statutes, and you shall heed My ordinances and do them, this is not referring to written statutes or ordinances, but the leading the Holy Spirit writes on our hearts now, particular to each person.

Jer 33:2-3 Thus says the Lord who made *the earth*, the Lord who formed it to establish it - the Lord is His name, 'Call to Me and I will answer you, and tell you [and even show you] great and mighty things, [things which have been confined and hidden], which you do not know *and* understand *and* cannot distinguish.'

Haggai 2:9 The latter glory of this house will be greater than the former, says the Lord of hosts. Note, God always saves the best for last, no matter how good it is, there is always more, always greater to appropriate and believe for.

Matt 10:16 (Jesus speaking) Listen carefully: I am sending you out like sheep among wolves; so be wise as serpents, and innocent as doves [have no self-serving agenda]. Note, one of my

confessions is that I am wary and wise as a snake and innocent as a dove and people respect me for both.

Matt 11:28-30 Come to Me, all you who labor and are heavy-laden *and* overburdened, and I will cause you to rest. [I will ease and relieve and refresh your souls.] Take My yoke upon you and learn of Me, for I am gentle (meek) and humble (lowly) in heart, and you will find rest (relief and ease and refreshment and recreation and blessed quiet) for your souls. For My yoke is wholesome (useful, good - not harsh, hard, sharp, or pressing, but comfortable, gracious, and pleasant), and My burden is light *and* easy to be borne.

Matt 12:35 The good man from his inner good treasure flings forth good things.

Mark 10:27 Looking at them, Jesus said, “With people [as far as it depends on them] it is impossible, but not with God; for all things are possible with God.”

Mark 11:24 (Jesus speaking) whatever things you ask for in prayer [in accordance with God’s will], believe [with confident trust] that you have received them, and they will be *given* to you.

Luke 17:6-8 And the Lord said, “If you have [confident, abiding] faith in God [even as small] as a mustard seed, you could say to this mulberry tree [which has very strong roots], ‘Be pulled up by the roots and be planted in the sea’; and [if the request was in agreement with the will of God] it would have obeyed you. “Which of you who has a servant plowing or tending sheep will say to him when he comes in from the field, ‘Come at once and sit down to eat?’ Will he not instead say to him, ‘Prepare something for me to eat, and *appropriately* clothe yourself [for service] and serve me while I eat and drink; then afterward you may eat and drink?’ Note, faith is our servant, put it to work while you relax and benefit.

John 6:28-29 Then they asked Him, “What are we to do, so that we may *habitually* be doing the works of God?” Jesus answered, “This is the work of God: that you believe [adhere to, trust in, rely on, and have faith] in the One whom He has sent.” Note, our only work is to believe in Jesus and his finished work.

John 13:3-5 (at Passover Feast) Jesus, knowing that the Father had put everything into His hands, and that He had come from God and was [now] returning to God, got up from supper, took off His [outer] robe, and taking a [servant’s] towel, He tied it around His waist. Then He poured water into the basin and began washing the disciples’ feet and wiping them with the towel which was tied around His waist. Note, this is our status now, God has put everything into our hands, He has blessed us with every blessing, all that He has is ours....when you have an abundance and confidence that God has already given you everything, you should be going about serving others instead of trying to serve yourself and better and improve your circumstances.

John 14:12-14 I assure you *and* most solemnly say to you, anyone who believes in Me [as Savior] will also do the things that I do; and he will do even greater things than these [in extent and outreach], because I am going to the Father. And I will do whatever you ask in My name [as

My representative], this I will do, so that the Father may be glorified *and* celebrated in the Son. If you ask Me anything in My name [as My representative], I will do it.

Romans 8:34 Who is there to condemn [us]? Will Christ Jesus (the Messiah), Who died, or rather Who was raised from the dead, Who is at the right hand of God actually pleading *as* He intercedes for us?

I Cor 1:4-5 I thank my God at all times for you because of the grace (the favor and spiritual blessing) of God which was bestowed on you in Christ Jesus, [So] that in Him in every respect you were enriched, in full power *and* readiness of speech [to speak of your faith] and complete knowledge *and* illumination [to give you full insight into its meaning].

I Cor 1:18 For the message of the cross is foolishness [absurd and illogical] to those who are perishing *and* spiritually dead [because they reject it], but to us who are being saved [by God's grace] it is [the manifestation of] the power of God. Note, If you are looking for God's power in your life, start meditating on Jesus' finished work on the cross.

I Cor 2:6-7 Yet when we are among the full-grown (spiritually mature Christians who are ripe in understanding), we do impart a [higher] wisdom (the knowledge of the divine plan previously hidden); but it is indeed not a wisdom of this present age *or* of this world nor of the leaders *and* rulers of this age, who are being brought to nothing *and* are doomed to pass away. But rather what we are setting forth is a wisdom of God once hidden [from the human understanding] and now revealed to us by God - [that wisdom] which God devised *and* decreed before the ages for our glorification [to lift us into the glory of His presence].

I Cor 6:12 Everything is permissible (allowable and lawful) for me; but not all things are helpful (good for me to do, expedient and profitable when considered with other things). Everything is lawful for me, but I will not become the slave of anything *or* be brought under its power.

II Cor 3:5 Not that we are fit (qualified and sufficient in ability) of ourselves to form personal judgments *or* to claim *or* count anything as coming from us, but our power *and* ability *and* sufficiency are from God. Note, our ability and sufficiency don't come from ourselves, but flow FROM God THROUGH us, making us able and sufficient and powerful.

II Cor 4:13 Yet we have the same spirit of faith as he had, who wrote *in Scripture*, "I believed, therefore I spoke." We also believe, therefore we also speak.

Gal 6:9 And let us not lose heart *and* grow weary *and* faint in acting nobly *and* doing right, for in due time *and* at the appointed season we shall reap, if we do not loosen *and* relax our courage *and* faint.

Eph 1:17-19 [I always pray] that the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may grant you a spirit of wisdom and of revelation [that gives you a deep and personal and intimate insight] into the true knowledge of Him [for we know the Father through the Son]. And [I pray] that the eyes of your heart [the very center and core of your being] may be enlightened [flooded with light by the Holy Spirit], so that you will know *and* cherish the hope [the divine guarantee,

the confident expectation] to which He has called you, the riches of His glorious inheritance in the saints (God's people), and [so that you will begin to know] what the immeasurable *and* unlimited *and* surpassing greatness of His [active, spiritual] power is in us who believe.

Eph 1 22-23 And He has put all things under His feet and has appointed Him the universal and supreme Head of the church [a headship exercised throughout the church], which is His body, the fullness of Him Who fills all in all [for in that body lives the full measure of Him Who makes everything complete, and Who fills everything everywhere with Himself].

Eph 2:6-7 And He raised us up together with Him and made us sit down together [giving us joint seating with Him](Note, resting, not working) in the heavenly sphere [by virtue of our being] in Christ Jesus (the Messiah, the Anointed One). He did this that He might clearly demonstrate through the ages to come the immeasurable (limitless, surpassing) riches of His free grace (His unmerited favor) in [His] kindness *and* goodness of heart toward us in Christ Jesus.

Eph 2:19 Therefore you are no longer outsiders (exiles, migrants, and aliens, excluded from the rights of citizens), but you now share citizenship with the saints (God's own people, consecrated and set apart for Himself); and you belong to God's [own] household.

Eph 3:20-21 Now to Him Who, by (in consequence of) the [action of His] power that is at work within us, is able to [carry out His purpose and] do superabundantly, far over *and* above all that we [dare] ask or think [infinitely beyond our highest prayers, desires, thoughts, hopes, or dreams] - to Him be glory in the church and in Christ Jesus throughout all generations forever and ever.

Eph 4:29 Let no foul *or* polluting language, *nor* evil word *nor* unwholesome *or* worthless talk [ever] come out of your mouth, but only such [speech] as is good *and* beneficial to the spiritual progress of others, as is fitting to the need *and* the occasion, that it may be a blessing *and* give grace (God's favor) to those who hear it. Note, speaking an encouraging word, a spiritually positive word to others literally causes God to give divine favor to them.

Eph 5:1 Therefore become imitators of God [copy Him and follow His example], as well-beloved children [imitate their father]; and walk *continually* in love [that is, value one another - practice empathy and compassion, unselfishly seeking the best for others], just as Christ also loved you and gave Himself up for us, an offering and sacrifice to God [slain for you, so that it became] a sweet fragrance.

Phil 2:13 For it is [not your strength, but it is] God who is effectively at work in you, both to will and to work [that is, strengthening, energizing, and creating in you the longing and the ability to fulfill your purpose] for His good pleasure. Note, God is at work in you.

Phil 3:13 Forgetting what *lies* behind and reaching forward to what *lies* ahead.

Phil 4:13 I can do all things [which He has called me to do] through Him who strengthens *and* empowers me [to fulfill His purpose - I am self-sufficient in Christ's sufficiency; I am ready for

anything and equal to anything through Him who infuses me with inner strength and confident peace.]

Col 1:13 [The Father] has delivered *and* drawn us to Himself out of the control *and* the dominion of darkness and has transferred us into the kingdom of the Son of His love. Note, we are citizens of heaven right now.

Col 1:15 He is the exact living image [the essential manifestation] of the unseen God [the visible representation of the invisible], the firstborn [the preeminent one, the sovereign, and the originator] of all creation. Note, Jesus is the will of God in action, a demonstration of God's will. He went about healing, showing love to sinners etc. those things are always God's will, then and now.

Col 3:2-3 Set your mind *and* keep focused *habitually* on the things above [the heavenly things], not on things that are on the earth [which have only temporal value]. For you died [to this world], and your [new, real] life is hidden with Christ in God. Note, set your mind, and keep it set on the truths God's Word says about you, not what the flesh and world are telling you!

Heb 10: 32-36 But be ever mindful of the days gone by in which, after you were first spiritually enlightened, you endured a great and painful struggle, sometimes being yourselves a gazingstock, publicly exposed to insults and abuse and distress, and sometimes claiming fellowship with others who were so treated, and you bore cheerfully the plundering of your belongings and the confiscation of your property, in the knowledge and consciousness that you yourselves had a better and lasting possession. Do not, therefore, fling away your FEARLESS CONFIDENCE, for it carries a great and glorious compensation and reward. For you have need of steadfast patience and endurance, so that you may perform and fully accomplish the will of God, and thus receive and carry away and enjoy to the full what is promised. Note: Once you receive revelation or enlightenment, you might start to see a great deal of affliction....don't cave, fight the good fight!

Heb 11:1 Now faith is the assurance (the confirmation, the title deed) of the things [we] hope for, being the proof of things [we] do not see *and* the conviction of their reality [faith perceiving as real fact what is not revealed to the senses].

Heb 11:32-35 And what more shall I say? For time will fail me if I tell of Gideon, Barak, Samson, Jephthah, of David and Samuel and the prophets, ³³ who by faith [that is, with an enduring trust in God and His promises] subdued kingdoms, administered justice, obtained promised blessings, closed the mouths of lions, ³⁴ extinguished the power of [raging] fire, escaped the edge of the sword, out of weakness were made strong, became mighty *and* unbeatable in battle, putting enemy forces to flight. Women received back their dead by resurrection.

Heb 13:20-21 Now may the God of peace [the source of serenity and spiritual well-being] who brought up from the dead our Lord Jesus, the great Shepherd of the sheep, through the blood *that sealed and ratified* the eternal covenant, equip you with every good thing to carry out His will *and* strengthen you [making you complete and perfect as you ought to be], accomplishing in us that which is pleasing in His sight, through Jesus Christ, to whom be the glory forever and ever.

Jam 3:16 For wherever there is jealousy (envy) and contention (rivalry and selfish ambition), there will also be confusion (unrest, disharmony, rebellion) and all sorts of evil *and* vile practices. Note, Envy and selfishness give permission for the enemy's evil to come into your life.

I Pet 1:8 Though you have not seen Him, you love Him; and though you do not even see Him now, you believe *and* trust in Him and you greatly rejoice *and* delight with inexpressible and glorious joy. You are a walking celebration!

I Pet 5:8 Be sober [well balanced and self-disciplined]. Note, live a balanced life!

2 Pet 1:3 For His divine power has bestowed upon us all things that [are requisite and suited] to life and godliness, through the [full, personal] knowledge of Him Who called us by *and* to His own glory and excellence (virtue).

I John 2:27 As for you, the anointing [the special gift, the preparation] which you received from Him remains [permanently] in you, and you have no need for anyone to teach you. But just as His anointing teaches you [giving you insight through the presence of the Holy Spirit] about all things, and is true and is not a lie, and just as His anointing has taught you, you must remain in Him [being rooted in Him, knit to Him].

AMPLIFIED BIBLE

The AMP was the first Bible project of The Lockman Foundation. Its goal was to take both word meaning and context into account to accurately translate the original text from one language into another. The AMP does this through the use of explanatory alternate readings and amplifications to assist the reader in understanding what Scripture really says. Multiple English word equivalents to each key Hebrew and Greek word clarify and amplify meanings that may otherwise have been concealed by the traditional translation method.

The Amplified Bible is free of personal interpretation and is independent of denominational prejudice. It is a translation from the accepted Hebrew, Aramaic, and Greek manuscripts into literary English. It is based on the American Standard Version of 1901, Rudolph Kittel's *Biblia Hebraica*, the Greek text of Westcott and Hort, and the 23rd edition of the Nestle Greek New Testament as well as the best Hebrew and Greek lexicons available at the time. Cognate languages, the Dead Sea Scrolls, and other Greek works were also consulted. The Septuagint and other versions were compared for interpretation of textual differences. In completing the Amplified Bible, translators made a determined effort to keep, as far as possible, the familiar wording of the earlier versions, and especially the feeling of the ancient Book.

The Bible was originally written in Hebrew, Aramaic, and Greek. There are shades of meaning found in these original Bible texts that can't be captured in a straight word-for-word translation into English. Dr. Frances Siewert had the vision for a translation that would use additional English words to convey the full meaning of Scripture to those who don't have the knowledge of the original languages. Using the word-for-word American Standard Version as a reference text, she chose additional words to communicate the nuances of meaning from the original texts. These "amplification" words are offset from the text by brackets or parentheses.

Parenthesis () and Dashes - : signify additional phases of meaning included in the original word, phrase, or clause of the original language.

Titles of Deity: are set off with commas.

Brackets: contain clarifying words or comments not actually expressed in the immediate original text.

Italics: point out some familiar passages now recognized as not adequately supported by the original manuscripts. "And," "or," and other connectives in italics indicate they have been added for readability in English.
